Promethazine is taken by mouth (oral), as a rectal suppository, or by injection into a muscle (IM). Chlorzoxazone It can also be administered for acute pain in general and for tension headache (muscle contraction headache). Possible side effects include dizziness, lightheadedness, malaise, nausea, vomiting. Conversely, chlorzoxazone may reduce the liver toxicity of acetaminophen by competitive inhibition. Opioid is dopamine antagonists such as domperidone and metoclopramide. Domperidone does not cross the blood-brain barrier and produce adverse central antidopaminergic Opioids are a class of drugs that derive from, or mimic, natural substances found in the opium poppy plant 10d6e52341

Opioids are also frequently used recreationally for their euphoric effects or to prevent withdrawal. Common side effects of promethazine include confusion and sleepiness; consumption of alcohol or other sedatives can make these symptoms worse. It is unclear if use of promethazine during pregnancy or breastfeeding is safe. Use of promethazine is not recommended in those less than two years old, due to potentially negative effects on breathing. Use of promethazine by injection into a vein is not recommended, due to potential skin damage. Promethazine is in the phenothiazine family of medications. It is used to relieve pain caused by muscle injuries such as strains and sprains, in combination with rest and physical therapy.
