Methylene blue Such a test is known as an MBAS assay (methylene blue active Methylthioninium chloride, commonly called methylene blue, is a salt used as a dye and as a medication. As a medication, it is mainly used to treat methemoglobinemia. methylene blue solution containing chloroform can detect anionic surfactants in a water sample. It has previously been used for treating cyanide poisoning and urinary tract infections, but this use is no longer recommended. Pregnancy test There is A pregnancy test is used to determine whether a woman is pregnant or not. Testing blood for hCG results in the earliest detection of pregnancy. the sample. Almost all pregnant women will have a positive urine pregnancy test one week after the first day of a missed menstrual period. Blood tests can detect hCG levels as low as 1 mIU/mL, and typically clinicians will diagnose a positive pregnancy test at 5mIU/mL. The two primary methods are testing for the pregnancy hormone (human chorionic gonadotropin (hCG)) in blood or urine using a pregnancy test kit, and scanning with ultrasonography 22e0391f49

Urination The process of urination is under voluntary control in healthy humans and other animals, but may occur as a reflex in infants, some elderly individuals, and those with neurological injury. It is the urinary system's form of excretion. The process of urination is the release of urine from the bladder through the urethra in placental mammals, or through the cloaca in other vertebrates. or, rarely, emiction, and known colloquially by various names including peeing, weeing, pissing, and euphemistically number one. The term luteinizing comes from the Latin "luteus", meaning "yellow". This is in reference to the corpus luteum, which is a mass of cells that forms in an ovary after an ovum (egg) has been discharged. The corpus luteum is so named because it often has a distinctive yellow color. The process of forming the corpus luteum is known as "luteinization", and thus the hormone that triggers this process is termed the "luteinizing" hormone.

22e0391f49 Urine is difficult to detect, as many of the naturally occurring compounds within urine are unstable (i.e., short-lived, quickly disappearing) and react freely with common disinfectants, such as chlorine, creating a large number of disinfection by-product (DBP) compounds from the original organic chemicals in urine. 22e0391f49

Luteinizing hormone rates, and recommendations of what time in the day to take the test varies between manufacturers and healthcare workers. The method was developed in the late 1940s at the University of Chicago by Willard Libby. It is based on the fact that radiocarbon (^{14}C) is constantly being created in the Earth's atmosphere by the interaction of cosmic rays with atmospheric nitrogen. The resulting ^{14}C combines with atmospheric oxygen to form radioactive carbon dioxide, which is incorporated into plants by photosynthesis; animals then acquire ^{14}C by eating the plants. When the animal or plant dies, it stops exchanging carbon with its environment, and thereafter the amount of ^{14}C it contains begins to decrease as the ^{14}C undergoes radioactive decay. Measuring the amount of ^{14}C in a sample from a dead plant or animal, such as a piece of wood or a fragment of bone, provides information that can be used to calculate when the animal or plant died. The older a sample is, the less ^{14}C there is to be detected. The half-life of ^{14}C (the period of time after which half of a given sample will have decayed... == Etymology == In recent years, methylene blue has been promoted for various health effects, but outside its established medical use, its safety and effectiveness are unproven; it is potentially toxic and should only be used under a doctor's prescription.

Colorless urine in drug tests can suggest an attempt to avoid detection of illicit drugs in the bloodstream Urine is the fluid excreted by the kidneys of vertebrates to clear the bloodstream of excess water and metabolic by-products including urea, uric acid, and creatinine. Football helmet This rule was enacted so that training staff and coaches can easily view a player’s A football helmet is a type of protective headgear used mainly in gridiron football, although a structural variation has occasional use in Australian rules football. High-school and pee-wee leagues prohibit all but clear visors. Although they are protective, players can and do still suffer head injuries such as concussions. It consists of a hard plastic shell with thick padding on the inside, a face mask made of one or more plastic-coated metal bars, and a chinstrap. Each position has a different type of face mask to balance protection and visibility, and some players add polycarbonate visors to their helmets, which are used to protect their eyes from glare and impacts. Helmets are a requirement at all levels of organized football, except for non-tackle variations such as flag football. amber
