Products are also promoted as a means to bypass smoke-free policies, marketed with slogans such as "smoke anywhere". US law mandates health warnings on e-cigarette packaging and advertisements: "WARNING: This product contains nicotine. Nicotine is an addictive chemical."

There were two key pieces of information that enabled Carr to stop later that day. First, the hypnotherapist told him smoking

was "just nicotine addiction", which Carr had never perceived before that moment, i.e. that he was an addict. Second, his son John lent him a medical handbook which explained that the physical withdrawal from nicotine is just like an "empty, insecure feeling".
