The strands are prone to mild to severe breakage, causing onset alopecia, especially during pregnancy. Fingernail and toenails tend to appear abnormal. The onset for this disease varies from person to person. Prevention measures include making changes to one's shaving technique: using sharp razors, avoiding too close a shave, using an astringent — such as alum — and an antiseptic — such as alcohol-based aftershave after shaving. The development of firearms, cannons, and explosive weaponry rendered armor intended to protect against enemy attack largely obsolete, but lightweight helmets remained for identification and basic protection purposes into the late 19th and early 20th centuries, when developments in modern warfare saw a renaissance of combat helmets designed to protect against shrapnel, debris, and some small-caliber firearm munitions. Prolonged cases of AKN can cause keloid formation due to chronic irritation.
