Temperate broadleaf and mixed forests These forests are richest and most distinctive in central China and. including temperate forest, mixed coniferous forest, and temperate rainforest ecoregions cd66170559

Temperate deciduous forest These forests are found in areas with distinct seasonal variation that cycle through warm, moist summers, cold winters, and moderate fall and spring seasons. Temperate deciduous forests provide several unique ecosystem services, including habitats for diverse wildlife, and they face a set of natural and human-induced disturbances that regularly alter their structure. Examples of trees typically growing in the Northern Hemisphere's deciduous forests include oak, maple, basswood, beech and elm, while in the Southern Hemisphere, trees of the genus Nothofagus dominate this type of forest. They are most commonly found in the Northern Hemisphere, with particularly large regions in eastern North America, East Asia, and a large portion of Europe, though smaller regions of temperate deciduous forests are also located in South America. Temperate forest A temperate forest is a forest found between the tropical and boreal regions, located in the temperate zone. These forests cover both hemispheres at latitudes ranging from 25 to 50 degrees, wrapping the planet in a belt similar to that of the boreal forest. It is the second largest terrestrial biome A temperate forest is a forest found between the tropical and boreal regions, located in the temperate zone. Due to its large size spanning several continents, there are several main types: deciduous, coniferous, mixed forest, and rainforest. It is the second largest terrestrial biome, covering 25% of the world's forest area, only behind the boreal forest, which covers about 33% cd66170559

Temperate rainforest Temperate rain forests. Temperate rain forests are rain forests with coniferous or broadleaf forests that occur in the temperate zone and receive heavy rain cd66170559

The climate of a temperate forest is highly variable depending on the location of the forest. Temperate rain forests comprise a relatively narrow Chilean coastal strip, between the Pacific Ocean to the west and the southern Andes Mountains to the east, from roughly 37° to 48° south latitude. North of 42°, the Chilean Coast Range stretches on, with just the north-south running Chilean Central Valley between it and the Andes. South of

42°, the coast range continues as a chain of offshore islands (including Chiloé Island and the Chonos Archipelago), while the "Central Valley" is submerged and continues as the Gulf of Corcovado. Much of the ecoregion was once covered by the Patagonian Ice Sheet and other glaciers during the peak of the last ice age, with ice descending from the Andes Mountains; numerous bodies of water within the... cd66170559
