Protriptyline Doses range from 15 to 40 mg per day and can be taken in one daily dose or divided into up to four doses daily. Some people with Protriptyline, sold under the brand name Vivactil among others, is a tricyclic antidepressant (TCA), specifically a secondary amine. 5 mg and 10 mg tablets. Like most antidepressants of this chemical and pharmacological class, protriptyline has also been used in limited numbers of patients to treat panic disorder, obsessive-compulsive disorder, attention-deficit/hyperactivity disorder, enuresis, eating disorders such as bulimia nervosa, cocaine dependency, and the depressive phase of bipolar disorder (manic-depressive) disorder. It has also been used to support smoking cessation programs. 3045b09403 Bupropion, when sold under the brand name Wellbutrin is indicated for depression. It is also sold as a smoking cessation drug, under the name Zyban. In Ontario, Canada, smoking cessation drugs are not covered by provincial drug plans. Thus, a physician can write a prescription for Wellbutrin to assist with giving up the habit of smoking. Alpha-1 blocker This is also the case for Tamsulosin and it may be assumed Alpha-1 blockers (also called alpha-adrenergic blocking agents or alpha-1 antagonists) constitute a variety of drugs that block the effect of catecholamines on alpha-1-adrenergic receptors. Alpha-1-adrenergic receptors are present in vascular smooth muscle, the central nervous system, and other tissues. or eliminated by gradual-dose titration, since the adverse effects of Prazosin are dose-related. They are mainly used to treat benign prostatic hyperplasia (BPH), hypertension and post-traumatic stress disorder. When alpha blockers bind to these receptors in vascular smooth muscle, they cause vasodilation

Serious side effects may include low blood pressure with standing and depression. Prazosin is a non-selective inverse agonist of the α_1 -adrenergic receptors. It works to decrease blood pressure by dilating blood vessels and helps with an enlarged prostate by

relaxing the outflow of the bladder. How it works in PTSD is not entirely clear.

Over the last 40 years, a variety of drugs have been developed from non-selective alpha-1 receptor antagonists to selective alpha-1 antagonists and alpha-1 receptor inverse agonists. The first drug that was used was a non-selective alpha blocker, named

phenoxybenzamine and was used to treat BPH. Currently, several relatively selective alpha-1 antagonists are available. As of 2018, prazosin is the only alpha-1 blocker known to act as an inverse agonist at all alpha-1 adrenergic receptor subtypes; whereas tamsulosin and terazosin are both selective antagonists for all alpha-1 subtypes. Tamsulosin is not centrally active due to poor blood-brain barrier penetration, but terazosin... 3045b09403 Historically, alpha-blockers were used as a tool for pharmacologic research to develop a greater understanding of the autonomic nervous system. Using alpha blockers, scientists began characterizing arterial blood pressure and central vasomotor control in the autonomic nervous system. Generally speaking, these treatments function by binding an α -blocker to α receptors in the arteries and smooth muscle. Ultimately, depending on the type of alpha receptor, this relaxes the smooth muscle or blood vessels, which increases fluid flow in these entities. 3045b09403 This group of drugs is related to sedatives. Whereas the term sedative describes drugs that serve to calm or relieve anxiety, the term hypnotic generally describes drugs whose main purpose is to initiate, sustain, or lengthen sleep.
