== Effects == 90e0d35710 Well over 200 virus strains are implicated in causing the common cold, with enteroviruses (especially rhinoviruses),

coronaviruses, and adenoviruses being the most common. They spread through the air or indirectly through contact with objects in the environment, followed by transfer to the mouth or nose. Risk factors include going to child care facilities, not sleeping well, and psychological stress. The symptoms are mostly due to the body's immune response to the infection rather than to tissue destruction by the viruses themselves. The material of the handle itself contributes to the growth of bacteria, with most door handles being constructed of stainless steel - a suitable home for bacteria. Herd immunity For both influenza and norovirus, epidemics temporarily Herd immunity (also called herd effect, community immunity, population immunity, or mass immunity) is a form of indirect protection that applies only to contagious diseases. memory T cells no longer recognize the virus, so people are not immune to the dominant circulating strain. It occurs when a sufficient percentage of a population has become immune to an infection,

whether through previous infections or vaccination, that the communicable pathogen cannot maintain itself in the population, its low incidence thereby reducing the likelihood of infection for individuals who lack immunity 90e0d35710

Once the herd immunity has been reached, disease gradually disappears from a population and may result in eradication or permanent reduction of infections to zero if achieved worldwide. Herd immunity created via vaccination has contributed to the reduction of many diseases. 90e0d35710

The virus is usually spread by the fecal-oral route. This may be through contaminated food or water or person-to-person contact. It may also spread via contaminated surfaces or through air from the vomit of an infected person. Risk factors include unsanitary food preparation and sharing close quarters. Diagnosis is generally based on symptoms. Confirmatory testing is not usually available but may

be performed by public health agencies during outbreaks. 90e0d35710

Virus Norovirus and rotavirus, common causes of viral gastroenteritis, are transmitted. including influenza viruses, SARS-CoV-2, chickenpox, smallpox, and measles 90e0d35710

As of November 2022 there were 302 cruise ships operating worldwide, with a combined capacity of 664,602 passengers. A crucial factor in the bacterial growth and spread is the location of the handle. A low-touch handle, such as that of a rarely opened closet will have significantly fewer bacteria than the high-touch handles in a busy public bathroom due to the frequency of contact with people's hands.
