Morphine Its maximum effect is reached after about 20 minutes when administered intravenously and 60 minutes when administered by mouth, while the duration of its effect is 3–7 hours. It acts directly on the central nervous system (CNS) to induce analgesia and alter perception and emotional response to pain. It can be taken for both acute pain and chronic pain and is frequently used for pain from myocardial infarction, kidney stones, and during labor. Physical and psychological dependence and tolerance may develop with repeated administration. Potentially serious side effects of morphine Morphine, formerly known as morphium, is an opiate found naturally in opium, a dark brown resin produced by drying the latex of opium poppies (*Papaver somniferum*). It is mainly used as an analgesic (pain medication). There are multiple methods used to administer morphine: oral; sublingual; via inhalation; injection into a muscle, injection under the skin, or injection into the spinal cord area; transdermal; intravenously; or via rectal suppository. Long-acting formulations of morphine are sold under the brand names MS Contin and Kadian, among others. Generic long-acting formulations are also available. Common side effects of morphine include drowsiness, euphoria, nausea, dizziness, sweating, and constipation 3147125242

Prasterone enanthate Dysmenorrhea Prasterone enanthate, also known as dehydroepiandrosterone enanthate (DHEA-E) and sold in combination with estradiol valerate under the brand name Gynodian Depot among others, is a weak androgen, estrogen, and neurosteroid medication which is used as a component of menopausal hormone therapy to treat menopausal symptoms in women. The side-effects may be rare but serious. The medication is given by injection into muscle typically once every 4 weeks. It is available only as an injectable preparation in combination with estradiol valerate. The free base form of the drug has been used to treat congenital myasthenic syndromes and approved by the FDA for Lambert-Eaton myasthenic syndrome (LEMS) through compassionate use programs since the 1990s and was recommended as a first line treatment for LEMS in 2006, using ad hoc forms of the drug, since there was no marketed form 3147125242

Gabapentin binds to $\alpha 2\delta$ subunits to modulate calcium channel function and neurotransmitter release, weakly affects glutamate signaling pathways, and does not act on GABA receptors. Sleepiness and dizziness are the most common side effects. Serious side effects include extreme sedation, respiratory depression and allergic reactions. In December 2008, the US Food and Drug Administration issued a class-wide warning for gabapentinoids for an increased risk of suicide.
