Canadian Cascade Arc Specifically, the southern end of the Canadian Cascades begin at the Canada-United States border. The IBM arc system formed as a result of subduction of the western Pacific plate. The IBM arc system now subducts mid-Jurassic to Early Cretaceous lithosphere, with younger lithosphere in the north and older lithosphere in the south, including the oldest (~170 million years old, or Ma) oceanic crust. Subduction rates vary from ~2 cm (1 inch) per year in the south to 6 cm (~2.5 inches) in the north. d22775911b

It is located along a section of the convergent plate boundary where the Philippine Sea Plate is subducting northwestward beneath the Eurasian Plate along the Ryukyu Trench. It runs parallel to the Okinawa Trough, an active volcanic arc, and the Ryukyu Trench. The arc has an overall northeast to southwest trend and is located northwest of the Pacific Ocean and southeast of the East China Sea. The geological units of the arc include igneous, sedimentary, and metamorphic rocks, ranging from the Paleozoic to Cenozoic in age. The Ryukyu Arc, based on its geomorphology, can be segmented from north to south into Northern Ryukyu, Central Ryukyu, and Southern Ryukyu; the Tokara Strait separates Northern Ryukyu and Central Ryukyu at about 130°E while the Kerama Gap separates Central Ryukyu and Southern Ryukyu at about 127 °E d22775911b

The statue was a gift of the Society of Women of France of New York (Société des Femmes de France de New York). The dedication ceremony took place on January 6, 1922, with President Warren G. Harding and First Lady Florence Harding in attendance. Speeches were given by French Ambassador Jean Jules Jusserand and Secretary of War John W. Weeks. A 17-gun salute fired from Fort Myer was the first time the United States military had fired such a salute in honor of a woman.
