Vaginal birth is the most common mode of birth worldwide. It involves three stages of labour: the shortening and opening of the cervix during the first stage, descent and birth of the baby during the second, and the birth of the placenta during the third. During the first stage, contractions gradually become stronger and closer together. The postpartum period is the time of recovery for the mother and infant, in which both newborn and mother are monitored. All major health organisations advise that immediately after giving birth, regardless of the mode of birth, that the infant be placed on the mother's chest (termed skin-to-skin contact), and to delay any other routine procedures for at least one to two hours or until the baby has had its first breastfeeding. 6b848ddcad A C-section typically takes between 45 minutes to an hour to complete. It may be done with a spinal block, where the woman is awake, or under general anesthesia. A urinary catheter is used to drain the bladder, and the skin of the abdomen is then cleaned with an antiseptic. Hysterectomy Supracervical hysterectomy refers to the removal of the uterus while the cervix is spared. Nearly 68 percent were performed for conditions such as endometriosis, irregular bleeding, and uterine fibroids. These procedures may also involve removal of the ovaries (oophorectomy), fallopian tubes (salpingectomy), and other surrounding structures. edges of the incision may be reapproximated, such as by using butterfly stitches, staples or sutures. These procedures are usually performed by a gynecologist. Removal of the uterus is a form of sterilization, rendering the patient unable to bear children (as does removal of ovaries and fallopian tubes) and has surgical risks as well as long-term effects, so the surgery is normally recommended only when other treatment options are not available or have failed. It is the second most commonly performed gynecological surgical procedure, after cesarean section, in the United States. It is expected that the frequency of hysterectomies for non-malignant indications will continue to fall, given the development of alternative treatment options. The terms "partial" or "total" hysterectomy are lay terms that incorrectly describe the addition or omission of oophorectomy at the time of hysterectomy. Postpartum period During the delayed phase, some changes to the genitourinary system take much longer to resolve and may result in conditions such as urinary incontinence. The World Health Organization (WHO) describes the postnatal period as the most critical and yet the most neglected phase in the lives of mothers and babies. However, more recent research shows that routine episiotomy, when a normal delivery without complications or instrumentation is anticipated, does not offer The postpartum (or postnatal) period begins after childbirth and is typically considered to last for six to eight weeks. Most maternal and newborn deaths occur during this period. There are three distinct phases of the postnatal period; the acute phase, lasting for six to twelve hours after birth; the subacute phase, lasting six weeks; and the delayed phase, lasting up to six months 6b848ddcad

Its use has decreased over the years in comparison to caesarean section. The two main instruments used are rotational forceps and vacuum extractors, each with different complication risks. Possible complications introduced with the use of instruments for the mother include pelvic floor injury, anal sphincter injury, bleeding, or cuts. Possible complications to the infant include bruising to the scalp, retinal bleeding, and scrapes to the scalp and face. 6b848ddcad The rare Parsonage-Turner syndrome causes brachial plexus inflammation without obvious injury, but with nevertheless disabling symptoms. 6b848ddcad Rash guards also offer some protection from the sun (measured by its Ultraviolet Protection Factor) and slight protection against jellyfish stings and are sometimes worn under wetsuits to prevent chafing. A rash guard helps to prevent irritation caused by rapid impact with surface water and waves as well. 6b848ddcad

A caesarean delivery may be performed based upon the shape of the mother's pelvis or history of a previous C-section. It is often performed because vaginal delivery would put the mother or child at risk of injury or death. The World Health Organization recommends that caesarean section be performed only when medically necessary. A trial of vaginal birth after C-section may be possible. Reasons for the operation include, but are not

limited to, obstructed labor, twin pregnancy, high blood pressure in the mother, breech birth, shoulder presentation, and problems with the placenta or umbilical cord 6b848ddcad
