Johns Hopkins Hospital is widely regarded as one of the world's greatest hospitals and medical institutions. For 21 consecutive years from 1991 to 2020, it was ranked as the best overall hospital in the United States by U.S. News & World Report. In its 2019–2020 edition, U.S. News & World Report ranked the hospital on 15 adult specialties and 10 children's specialties; the hospital came in 1st in Maryland and third nationally behind the Mayo Clinic... In 2007, the School of Professional Studies in Business and Education at Johns Hopkins University was split into two new schools, the Johns Hopkins Carey Business School and the Johns Hopkins School of Education.
