Ovulation Ovulation is stimulated by an increase in luteinizing hormone (LH). Ovulation will occur between 24 and 36 hours after the HCG injection. chorionic gonadotropin (HCG) may be injected after completed ovarian stimulation. In female humans ovulation typically occurs near the midpoint in the menstrual cycle and after the follicular phase. By contrast Ovulation is an important part of the menstrual cycle in female vertebrates where the egg cells are released from the ovaries as part of the ovarian cycle. There are several different types of GTD. A hydatidiform mole also known as a molar pregnancy, is the most common and is usually benign. Sometimes it may develop into an invasive mole, or, more rarely into a choriocarcinoma. A choriocarcinoma is likely to spread quickly, but is very sensitive to chemotherapy, and has a very good prognosis. Trophoblasts are of particular interest to cell biologists because, like cancer, they can invade tissue (the uterus), but unlike cancer, they usually "know" when to stop. 919a52756f

Throughout history, there have been different animal-based tests with the aim of indicating the pregnancy status of women. If it is not, it will break down in less than a day. Meanwhile, the uterine lining (endometrium) continues to thicken to be able to receive a fertilized egg. The rationale is that a low β -hCG level may indicate that the pregnancy is intrauterine Ectopic pregnancy is a complication of pregnancy in which the embryo attaches outside the uterus. Gestational trophoblastic disease The proposed mechanism is attaching hCG to TSH receptors and acting like Gestational trophoblastic disease (GTD) is a term used for a group of pregnancy-related tumours. hyperthyroidism as well as an increase in the levels of thyroid hormones in some patients. These tumours are rare, and they appear when cells in the womb start to proliferate uncontrollably. The cells that form gestational trophoblastic tumours are called trophoblasts and come from tissue that grows to form

Pregnancy tests using animals to detect hCG levels in the blood. Advancements in medical technology have enabled women to accurately check their pregnancy status by using 'pee-on-a-stick' pregnancy test kits at home. Before these accessible and convenient test kits were invented, scientists strived to discover a way in spotting pregnancy-related hormones by a natural, simple test, where animals were often included as clinical tools to facilitate the process. The pee-on-a-stick pregnancy test only detects the presence of hCG, and cannot measure the level of hCG in the blood Before immunological pregnancy tests were developed in the 1960s, women relied on urine-based pregnancy tests using animals, ranging from mice to frogs 919a52756f

The term "multiple-marker screening test" is sometimes used instead. This term can encompass the "double test" and "quadruple test" (described below).

It is complemented in some regions of the United States, as the Quad screen (adding inhibin A to the panel, resulting in an 81% sensitivity and 5% false-positive rate for detecting Down syndrome when taken at 15–18 weeks of gestational age) and other prenatal diagnosis techniques, although it remains widely used in Canada and other countries. A positive screen indicates an increased risk of chromosomal abnormalities (and neural tube defects), and such patients are then referred for more sensitive and specific procedures to receive a definitive diagnosis, often prenatal diagnosis via amniocentesis, although the stronger screening option of cell-free fetal... 919a52756f

Velamentous cord insertion Velamentous cord insertion occurs in Velamentous cord insertion is a complication of pregnancy where the umbilical cord is inserted in the fetal membranes. Without Wharton's jelly protecting

the vessels, the exposed vessels are susceptible to compression and rupture. The vessels are hence normally protected by Wharton's jelly, which prevents rupture during pregnancy and labor. In normal pregnancies, the umbilical cord inserts into the middle of the placental mass and is completely encased by the amniotic sac. In velamentous cord insertion, the vessels of the umbilical cord are improperly inserted in the chorioamniotic membrane, and hence the vessels traverse between the amnion and the chorion towards the placenta. complications particularly arise in the case of monochorionic twins, where identical twins share the same placenta. It is a major cause of antepartum hemorrhage that leads to loss of fetal blood and associated with high perinatal mortality 919a52756f

Overall, ectopic pregnancies annually affect less than 2% of pregnancies worldwide. Risk factors for ectopic pregnancy include pelvic inflammatory disease, often due to chlamydia infection; tobacco smoking; endometriosis; prior tubal surgery; a history of infertility; and the use of assisted reproductive technology. Those who have previously had an ectopic pregnancy are at much higher risk of having another one. Most ectopic pregnancies (90%) occur in the fallopian tube, which are known as tubal pregnancies, but implantation can also occur on the cervix, ovaries, caesarean scar, or within the abdomen... 919a52756f

919a52756f FSH is a 35.5 kDa glycoprotein heterodimer, consisting of two polypeptide units, alpha and beta. Its structure is similar to those of luteinizing hormone (LH), thyroid-stimulating hormone (TSH), and human chorionic gonadotropin (hCG). The alpha subunits of the glycoproteins LH, FSH, TSH, and hCG are identical and consist of 96 amino acids, while the beta subunits vary. Both subunits are required for biological activity. FSH has a beta subunit of 111 amino acids (FSH β), which confers its specific biologic action, and is responsible for interaction with the follicle-stimulating hormone receptor. The sugar portion of the hormone is covalently bonded to asparagine, and is composed of N-acetylgalactosamine, mannose, N-acetylglucosamine, galactose, and sialic acid.

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
