Dupilumab Dupilumab, sold under the brand name Dupixent, is a monoclonal antibody blocking interleukin 4 and interleukin 13 receptor signalling (IL-4R, IL-13R), Dupilumab, sold under the brand name Dupixent, is a monoclonal antibody blocking interleukin 4 and interleukin 13 receptor signalling (IL-4R, IL-13R), used for allergic diseases such as atopic dermatitis (eczema), asthma and nasal polyps which result in chronic sinusitis. It is also used for the treatment of eosinophilic esophagitis, prurigo nodularis and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease bc29f1173c

Atopic dermatitis affects about 20% of people at some point in their lives. It is more common in younger children. Females are affected slightly more often than males. Millions of people have outgrown the condition. bc29f1173c The most common side effects reported by the US Food and Drug Administration (FDA) include injection site reactions, upper respiratory tract infections, joint pain, and herpes viral infections. The most common side effects reported by the European Medicines Agency (EMA) include injection-site reactions (such as redness, swelling including due to fluid build-up, itching and pain), conjunctivitis (redness and discomfort in the eye) including conjunctivitis due to allergy, joint pain, cold sores, and increased blood levels of a type of white blood cell called eosinophils. It was developed by Regeneron Pharmaceuticals and Sanofi Genzyme. It received approval from the US Food and Drug Administration (FDA) for moderate-to-severe atopic dermatitis in 2017, and for asthma in 2018. The FDA considers it... bc29f1173c Both Dr's Rapaport and Sato note that atopic dermatitis has a natural tendency to self-heal over time. bc29f1173c While the condition may occur at any age, it typically begins in childhood, with varying severity over the years. In children under one year of age, the face, limbs, and much of the body may be affected. As children get older, the areas on the insides of the knees and folds of the elbows and around the neck are most commonly affected. In adults, the hands and feet are commonly affected. Scratching the affected areas worsens the eczema and increases the risk of skin infections. Many people with atopic dermatitis develop hay fever or asthma. bc29f1173c

While the Food and Drug Administration's Center for Drug Evaluation and Research tracks first-in-class medications and reports on them annually, first-in-class is not considered a regulatory category. Anti-asthmatic agents as rescue medications for acute asthma attacks include short-acting β 2-adrenergic receptor agonists (SABA), short-acting muscarinic antagonists (SAMA), systemic glucocorticoids, and magnesium sulfate. Anti-asthmatic agents as maintenance medications for asthmatic symptom control include long-acting β 2-adrenergic receptor agonists (LABA), inhaled glucocorticoids, long-acting muscarinic antagonists (LAMA), methylxanthines/phosphodiesterase inhibitors, leukotriene receptor antagonists, mast cell stabilizers, and certain types of monoclonal antibodies. bc29f1173c

Topical steroid withdrawal and dupilumab (Dupixent). Red Skin Syndrome (RSS) became commonly known as Topical Steroid Withdrawal (TSW). Marvin Rapaport first recognized 'Red Skin Syndrome' (RSS) at his UCLA clinic, where he established the connection between topical steroid use, cessation, and subsequent severe skin reactions. Some physicians have also seen positive outcomes with oral doxycycline or topical clindamycin. Dr Rapaport identified this as 'Topical Steroid Addiction' (TSA), a potential side effect from topical steroid use (iatrogenic condition). The prevalence of the condition Dr bc29f1173c

Dr. Kenji Sato, Japanese dermatologist at Hannan Chuo Hospital in Osaka, has pioneered TSA treatment through dedicated inpatient care as well as developed a No Moisture Therapy (NMT) protocol for patients to follow at home. bc29f1173c The condition has been reported in people who apply topical steroids for 2 weeks or longer and then discontinue use. Aspirin-exacerbated respiratory disease Compared to aspirin tolerant patients, AERD patients' asthma and nasal polyps are generally more severe. AERD most commonly begins in early- to mid-adulthood and has no known cure. guidelines. Reduction or loss of the ability to smell is extremely common, occurring in more than 90% of people with the disease. Among biologics and aspirin desensitization and therapy, dupilumab (Dupixent) was shown to be the most effective across six different patient-important Aspirin-exacerbated respiratory disease (AERD), also called NSAID-exacerbated respiratory disease (N-ERD) or historically aspirin-induced asthma and Samter's triad, is a long-term disease defined by three simultaneous symptoms: asthma, chronic rhinosinusitis with nasal polyps, and intolerance of aspirin and other nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drugs (NSAIDs). While NSAID intolerance is a defining feature of AERD, avoidance of NSAIDs does not affect the onset, development or perennial nature of the disease bc29f1173c

Atopic dermatitis These include dupilumab (Dupixent), tralokinumab (Adtralza, Adbry), abrocitinib (Cibinqo) Atopic dermatitis (AD), also known as atopic eczema, is chronic type of inflammation of the skin. Atopic dermatitis is also often called simply eczema, but "eczema" is also used to refer to dermatitis, the larger group of skin conditions. Clear fluid may come from the affected areas, which can thicken over time. Atopic dermatitis results in itchy, red, swollen, and cracked skin.
