

Dilation And Curettage Meaning

The Criminal Code is currently enforced in the southern states. The abortion laws of the Criminal Code are expressed within sections 228, 229, and 230. Section 228 states that any doctor who acts with the intention to cause a miscarriage to a woman is guilty of a felony, with conviction of the charge carrying up to 14 years of imprisonment. Section 229 states that any woman obtaining a miscarriage is guilty of a felony and may be sentenced to imprisonment for up to 7 years. Abortion in South Africa It is also legal to terminate a pregnancy between weeks 13 and 20 if the continued pregnancy would significantly affect the woman's social or economic circumstances, poses a risk of injury to the woman's physical or mental health, there is a substantial risk that the foetus would have a severe physical or mental problems, or the pregnancy resulted from rape or incest. however some white women, could request private doctors to perform a dilation and curettage, on the grounds that the continuation of pregnancy threatened the Abortion in South Africa is legal by request (no reason needs to be provided) when the pregnancy is under 13 weeks. If the pregnancy is more than 20 weeks, a termination is legal if the foetus' life is in danger, or there is a likelihood of serious birth defects 74606996e7

In humans, the lower end of the uterus is a narrow part known as the isthmus that connects to the cervix, the anterior gateway leading to the vagina. The upper end, the body of the uterus, is connected to the fallopian tubes at the uterine horns; the rounded part, the fundus, is above the openings to the fallopian tubes. The connection of the uterine cavity with a fallopian tube is called the uterotubal junction. The fertilized egg is carried to the uterus along the fallopian tube. It will have divided on its journey to form a blastocyst that will implant itself into the lining of the uterus – the endometrium, where it will receive nutrients and develop into the embryo proper, and later fetus, for the duration of the pregnancy... 74606996e7

Late termination of pregnancy As of 2015, in the United States, more than 90% of abortions occur before the 13th week, 1. providers offer abortions at 20 weeks of gestation and later, most often using a method called dilation and evacuation (D&E). 3% take place after the 21st week, and less than 1% occur after 24 weeks. In this context, late is not precisely defined, and different medical publications use varying gestational age thresholds. While little data exists on abortions done after 26 weeks, one study from 1992 estimated the rate at 0. 02%. Severe bleeding may result in a fast heart rate, fainting, or shock. The pain may be described as sharp, dull, or crampy. failing PULs and IUPs. Dilation and curettage (D&C) is sometimes used to diagnose pregnancy location to differentiate between an EP and a non-viable IUP Ectopic pregnancy is a complication of pregnancy in which the embryo attaches outside the uterus. Overall, ectopic pregnancies annually affect less than 2% of pregnancies worldwide. Risk factors for ectopic pregnancy include pelvic inflammatory disease, often due to chlamydia infection; tobacco smoking; endometriosis; prior tubal surgery; a history of infertility; and the use of assisted reproductive technology. Those who have previously had an ectopic pregnancy are at much higher risk of having another one. Most ectopic pregnancies (90%) occur in the fallopian tube, which are known as tubal pregnancies, but implantation can also occur on the cervix, ovaries, caesarean scar, or within the abdomen... 74606996e7

Endometrial cancer It is the result of the abnormal growth of cells that can invade or spread to other parts of the body. Endometrial cancer occurs most commonly after menopause. A pap smear is not typically sufficient to show endometrial cancer Endometrial cancer is a cancer that arises from the endometrium (the lining of the uterus or womb). endometrial biopsy or by taking samples during a procedure known as dilation and curettage. The first sign is most often vaginal bleeding not associated with a menstrual period. Other symptoms include pain with urination, pain during sexual intercourse, or pelvic pain 74606996e7

Stenberg v. Carhart Casey and Roe v. Nebraska physicians who performed the procedure contrary to the law were subject to having their medical licenses revoked. Carhart, 530 U. 914 (2000), was a landmark decision of the United States Supreme Court dealing with a Nebraska law which made performing "partial-birth abortion" illegal, without regard for the health of the mother. called "D&X" (Dilation and Extraction), which, rather than commencing curettage inside the uterus, extracts part of the fetus first and then begins the Stenberg v. Wade. S. The Court struck down the law, finding the Nebraska statute criminalizing "partial birth abortion[s]" violated the Due Process Clause of the United States Constitution, as interpreted in Planned Parenthood v 74606996e7

LeRoy Carhart, a Nebraska physician who specialized in late-term abortions, brought suit against Don Stenberg, the Attorney General of Nebraska, seeking declaratory judgment that a state law banning certain forms of abortion was unconstitutional, based on the undue burden test mentioned by a dissenting opinion in Akron v. Akron Center for Reproductive Health and by the Court in Planned Parenthood v. Casey. Both a federal district court and the U.S. Court of Appeals ruled in favor of Carhart before the... 74606996e7 In the United States, the mortality rate for legal abortions overall is less than 1 in 100,000 procedures performed. The rate of mortality and morbidity increases with the gestational age of the fetus, so patients who have decided to have an abortion are strongly encouraged to get it early. Still, later abortion is not associated with any greater net negative physical or mental health outcomes... 74606996e7 Abortion is provided for free at some government hospitals and clinics. A request for this service must be made at a primary healthcare clinic and a referral letter will be provided to a facility that offers abortion care. Abortion is provided for a fee at private clinics. Marie Stopes South Africa and Abortion Support South Africa provide abortion pills for home-use (self-managed abortion) across the country. 74606996e7 Curettages are also a method of abortion. Northern Nigeria is governed by The Penal Code and Southern Nigeria is governed by The Criminal Code. The only legal way to have an abortion in Nigeria is if having the child is going to put the mother's life in danger. Hospital-based dilatation and curettage, hospital-and clinic-based manual vacuum aspiration, and medical abortion Abortion is a controversial topic in Nigeria. During a molar pregnancy, the uterus contains a growing mass characterized by swollen chorionic villi, resembling clusters of grapes. The occurrence of a molar pregnancy can be attributed to the fertilized egg lacking an original maternal nucleus. As a result, the products of conception may or may not contain fetal tissue. These molar pregnancies are categorized into two types: partial moles and complete moles, where the term 'mole' simply denotes a clump of growing tissue or a 'growth'. 74606996e7 A complete mole is caused by either a single sperm (90% of the time) or two sperm (10% of the time) combining with an egg that has lost its DNA. In the former case, the sperm reduplicates, leading to the formation of a "complete" 46-chromosome set. Typically, the genotype is 46, XX (diploid) due to subsequent mitosis of the fertilizing sperm, but it can also be 46, XY (diploid). However, 46, YY (diploid) is not observed. On the other hand, a partial mole occurs when a normal egg is fertilized... 74606996e7 Gingival curettage is a surgical procedure designed to remove the soft tissue lining of the periodontal pocket with a curet, leaving only a gingival connective tissue lining. ... Gingival curettage, as originally conceived, was designed to promote new connective tissue attachment to the tooth, by the removal of pocket lining and junctional epithelium. Since there is no evidence that gingival curettage has any therapeutic benefit in the treatment of chronic periodontitis, the American Dental Association has deleted that code from the fourth edition of Current Dental Terminology (CDT-4). In addition, the American Academy of Periodontology, in its Guidelines for Periodontal Therapy, did not include gingival curettage as a method of treatment. This indicates that the dental community as a whole regards gingival curettage as a procedure with no clinical value. 74606996e7

Reasons for late terminations of pregnancy include cases where a pregnant woman's health is at risk, when birth defects, such as lethal fetal abnormalities, have been detected, or when barriers to receiving abortion cause delays. 74606996e7 Approximately 40% of cases are related to obesity. Endometrial cancer is also associated with excessive estrogen exposure, high blood pressure and diabetes. Whereas taking estrogen alone increases the risk of endometrial cancer, taking both estrogen and a progestogen in combination, as in most birth control pills, decreases the risk. Between two and five percent of cases are related to genes inherited from the parents. Endometrial cancer is sometimes called "uterine cancer", although it is distinct from other forms of cancer of the uterus such as cervical cancer, uterine sarcoma, and trophoblastic disease. Misoprostol The misoprostol-only abortion regimen is typically recommended only when mifepristone is not available. with softening and dilation of the cervix. Misoprostol binds to and stimulates prostaglandin EP2 receptors, prostaglandin EP3 receptor and prostaglandin Misoprostol is a synthetic prostaglandin medication used to prevent and treat stomach and duodenal ulcers, induce labor, cause an abortion, and treat postpartum bleeding due to poor contraction of the uterus. Its efficacy with mifepristone is higher, but varies based on gestational age. By itself, effectiveness for abortion is between 82% and 100%. It is taken by mouth when used to prevent gastric ulcers in people taking nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drugs (NSAID). For labor induction or abortion, it is taken by mouth, dissolved in the mouth, or placed in the vagina. For postpartum bleeding it may

also be used rectally. For abortions it is typically used in conjunction with mifepristone or methotrexate, but can be used alone 74606996e7
