It is recited after one engages in an act of excretion or urination, but is also included in many Jewish prayer books as a part of daily prayer prior to birkot hashachar fca2606141

Caregivers try to recognize and respond to babies' bodily needs and enable them to urinate and defecate in an appropriate place (e. Some practitioners of EC begin soon after birth, the optimum window being zero to four months in terms of helping the baby get in tune with their elimination needs, although it can be started with babies of any age. Caregivers may use diapers (nappies) as a back-up in case of "misses" some or all of the time, or not at all. EC emphasizes communication between the caregiver and child, helping them both become more attuned to the child's innate rhythms and control of urination and defecation. Timing varies radically Elimination communication (EC) is a practice in which a caregiver uses timing, signals, cues, and intuition to address an infant's need to eliminate waste. g. Only a small percentage (5 to 10%) of bedwetting cases have a specific medical cause. Bedwetting is commonly associated with a family history of the condition. Nocturnal enuresis is considered primary when a child has not yet had a prolonged period of being dry. "[5:6] Wudu by itself is mustahabb Wudu' (Arabic: وضوء, romanized: wuḍū', lit. hands. 'ablution' [wə'dʰuːʔ]) is the procedure for cleansing parts of the body, a type of ritual purification by ablution, in Islam. The steps of wudu are: washing the hands, rinsing the mouth and nose, washing the face, then the forearms, then wiping the head and ears, then washing or wiping the feet, done in order without any long breaks between them fca2606141

Wudu is typically performed before Salah or reading the Quran. Activities that invalidate wudu include urination, defecation, flatulence, deep sleep, light bleeding (depending on madhhab), menstruation, postpartum status, and sexual intercourse. fca2606141

False awakening After a false awakening, subjects often dream they are performing their daily morning routine such as showering or eating breakfast. False awakenings, particularly those in which individuals dream they have awakened from a sleep that involved dreaming, take on aspects of a double dream or a dream within a dream.
