Euchromatin is composed of repeating subunits known as nucleosomes, reminiscent of an unfolded set of beads on a string, that are approximately 11 nm in diameter. At the core of these nucleosomes are a set of four histone protein pairs: H3, H4, H2A, and H2B. Each core histone protein possesses a 'tail' structure, which can vary in several ways; it is thought that these variations act as "master control switches" through different methylation and acetylation states, which determine the overall arrangement of the chromatin.... 9868b3deeb == Overview == 9868b3deeb In addition to increasing the volume of... 9868b3deeb In eukaryotes, euchromatin comprises the most active portion of the genome within the cell nucleus. In prokaryotes, euchromatin is the only form of chromatin present; this indicates that the heterochromatin structure evolved later along with the nucleus, possibly as a mechanism to handle increasing genome size. 9868b3deeb

Polytene chromosomes, at interphase, are seen to have patterns of distinct thick and thin bands. These patterns were originally used to help map chromosomes, identify small chromosome mutations, and in taxonomic identification. Insulator (genetics) as both a barrier to chromatin-mediated silencing via heterochromatin spreading, and blocks interactions between enhancers and promoters. A distinguishing 9868b3deeb

Euchromatin Euchromatin stands in contrast to heterochromatin, which is tightly packed and less accessible for transcription. Sex-chromosome dosage compensation along the male X chromosome, their effects spread along the length of the chromosome and have the ability to influence large-scale chromatin modifications 9868b3deeb

Chromatin remodeling , histone acetyltransferases (HATs), histone deacetylases (HDACs), methyltransferases, and kinases, and 2) ATP-dependent chromatin remodeling complexes which either move, eject or restructure nucleosomes. Besides actively regulating gene expression, dynamic remodeling of chromatin imparts an epigenetic regulatory role in several key biological processes, egg cells DNA replication and repair; apoptosis; chromosome segregation as well as development and pluripotency. They are produced when repeated rounds of DNA replication without cell division occur. Thus polytene chromosomes form when multiple rounds of replication produce many sister chromatids which stay fused together. 9868b3deeb

Polycomb-group proteins chromatin sites is performed by SWI/SNF complexes, which oppose the accumulation of Polycomb complexes through ATP-dependent eviction. X chromosome inactivation 9868b3deeb

== Function == 9868b3deeb Polytene chromosomes were first reported by E.G.Balbiani in 1881. Polytene chromosomes are found in dipteran flies: the best understood are those of Drosophila,

Chironomus and Rhynchosciara. They are present in another group of arthropods of the class Collembola, a protozoan group Ciliophora, mammalian trophoblasts and antipodal, and suspensor cells in plants. In insects, they are commonly found in the salivary glands when the cells are enlarged but not divided. 9868b3deeb

Polytene chromosome They provide a high level of function in certain tissues such as salivary glands of insects. The interbands are involved in the interaction with the active chromatin proteins Polytene chromosomes are large chromosomes which have thousands of DNA strands. the X chromosome which results in the Bar phenotype of kidney-shaped eyes 9868b3deeb

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
