GL is a GI-weighted measure of carbohydrate content. For instance, watermelon has a high GI, but a typical serving of watermelon does not contain many carbohydrates, so the glycemic load of eating it is low. Whereas glycemic index is defined for each type of food, glycemic load can be calculated for any size serving of a food, an entire meal, or an entire day's meals. adf8f81baa

One unit of glycemic load The glycemic load (GL) of food is a number that estimates how much the food will raise a person's blood glucose level after it is eaten. Glycemic load is based on the glycemic index (GI), and is calculated by multiplying the weight of available carbohydrate in the food (in grams) by the food's glycemic index, and then dividing by 100. glycemic load (GL) of food is a number that estimates how much the food will raise a person's blood glucose level after it is eaten.
