Given the "difficulty learning in a typical manner", this does not exclude the ability to learn in a different manner. In the United Kingdom, the term learning disability generally refers to an intellectual disability, while conditions such as dyslexia and dyspraxia are usually referred to as learning difficulties

For some people, it works best to both do similar tasks, while for others, just being in the same (real or virtual) room is enough. It involves the physical presence, virtual presence through a phone call, videotelephony or social media presence, of someone with whom one shares their goals, which makes it more likely to achieve them
