In 1834, Charles Wheatstone developed a method of using a rapidly rotating mirror to study electric sparks and applied this method to measure the velocity of electricity in a wire. In 1975, the GRM was integrated with the new Institut national de l'audiovisuel (INA) with Bayle as its head, which post he held until 1997.
