The wild turkey was formally described in 1758 by the Swedish naturalist Carl Linnaeus in the tenth edition of his *Systema Naturae* under its current binomial name *Meleagris gallopavo*. The type locality is Mexico. The genus name *Meleagris* is from Ancient Greek *μελεαγρις*/*meleagris* meaning "guineafowl". The specific epithet *gallopavo* is a late Medieval Latin word for a wild turkey: it combines Latin *gallus* meaning "fowl" and *pavo* meaning "peacock". The word was used in 1555 by the Swiss naturalist Conrad Gessner in his *Historiae animalium*. The Tasmanian Devil comes roaring in and spots Bugs still reading the booklet. After Bugs says "What?!
