It ranks fifth in the literacy rate which is 83.78%, higher than the national rate. It ranks fourth in life expectancy at 67 years, higher than the national rate of 65.4 years. Nurpur is located at 32.3°N 75.9°E / 32.3; 75.9. It has an average elevation of 643 metres (2109 feet).
