NC should therefore be distinguished from vascular claudication, which stems from a circulatory problem rather than a neural one. They are therefore used in medicine to treat diseases caused by an overactive immune system, such as allergies, asthma, autoimmune diseases, and sepsis. Glucocorticoids have many side effects, including adverse drug reactions. They also interfere with some of the abnormal mechanisms in cancer cells, so they are used in high doses to treat cancer. In particular, they inhibit lymphocyte proliferation, which is significant for lymphomas and leukemias.
