Apothecaries' system The apothecaries' system of measures is a similar system of volume units based on the fluid ounce. This exact form of the system was used in the United Kingdom; in some of its former colonies, it survived well into the 20th century. civil weight systems had the same ounces ("an ounce is an ounce"), but the civil pound consisted of 16 ounces. It divides a pound into 12 ounces, an ounce into 8 drachms, and a drachm into 3 scruples of 20 grains each. Informal measurements such as a "pinch", a "drop", or a "hint" (soupçon) continue to be used from time to time.
