Others trace it back to 1966, when the Palm Beach Post used it in a story: "Adults, when under severe emotional stress, turn to what could be called 'comfort food'—food associated with the security of childhood, like mother's poached egg or famous chicken soup." According to research by April White at JSTOR, it might have been Liza Minnelli who used the term for the first time in its modern meaning in an interview, admitting to craving a hamburger. 2c4a34d9ba

Herring as food The most abundant and commercially important species belong to the genus Clupea, found particularly in shallow, temperate waters of the North Pacific and North Atlantic Oceans, including the Baltic Sea, as well as off the west coast of South America. Three species of Clupea are recognized; the main taxon, the Atlantic herring, accounts for over half the world's commercial capture of herrings. mercury, and listeria. There is a (rare) risk of harmful bacteria from eating raw herring eggs. They are an important food for humans. Herring often move in large schools around fishing banks and near the coast. This type of sausage was culturally imported from Germany and popularized in the United States in the 19th and 20th century, where it became a working-class street food sold at hot dog stands and carts. It is also sold at fast-food restaurants and convenience stores, as well as being available for home preparation after being

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purchased at grocery stores. The hot dog became closely associated with cookouts, and sporting events such as baseball and American culture. It has become a popular street food and concessions stand menu item globally, besides from home preparation. There are many variations in topping and styles; in many cases a certain style becomes popular in a certain region, and in particular there is variation in the toppings, preparation, and type of sausage and bun. 2c4a34d9ba Hot dogs are a very popular sandwich throughout the United States. In the 1970s, the most popular comfort food in the United States were various potato... 2c4a34d9ba Street foods—ready-to-eat food or drink sold in a street or other public place, such as a market or fair, by a hawker or vendor, often from a portable stall— have variations within both regions and cultures. For example, Dorling Kindersley describes the street food of Vietnam as being "fresh and lighter than many of the cuisines in the area" and "draw[ing] heavily on herbs, chile peppers and lime," while street food of Thailand is "fiery" and "pungent with shrimp paste... and fish sauce" with New York City's signature street food being the hot dog, although the offerings in New York also range from "spicy Middle Eastern falafel or Jamaican jerk chicken to Belgian waffles."
