Police station Barracks, used by American state police and highway patrol agencies, as well as in Ireland District office, used by American state police and highway patrol A police station is a facility operated by police or a similar law enforcement agency that serves to accommodate police officers and other law enforcement personnel. The role served by a police station varies by agency, type, and jurisdiction, but in larger agencies there may be multiple police stations that serve as regional or area sub-headquarters for personnel assigned to certain beats, administrative divisions, or police units, while in smaller agencies there may be fewer stations or even one singular police headquarters f5d7d52911

According to Law 7187/2025 which reorganized, upgraded and modernized the Hellenic Police's structure, mission and modus operandi, replacing the previous Law 2800/2000, the Hellenic Police is a security force whose primary missions are: f5d7d52911

Hellenic Police Police Lieutenant General Dimitrios Mallios is Chief of the Hellenic Police. It is a large agency with responsibilities ranging from road traffic control to counter-terrorism. The Hellenic Police force was established in 1984 under Law 1481/1-10-1984 (Government Gazette 152/A/8-10-1984) as the result of the merger of the Gendarmerie (Χωροφυλακή, Chorofylakí, 1833–1984) and the Cities Police (Αστυνομία Πόλεων, Astynomía Póleon, 1921–1984) forces. It is also The Hellenic Police (Greek: Ελληνική Αστυνομία, romanized: Ellinikí Astynomía, abbreviated ΕΛ.) is the national police service and one of the three security forces of Greece (the others being the Hellenic Fire Service and the Hellenic Coast Guard). conducts background checks before admitting citizens to the Police Academy, as well as at regular intervals throughout their police career. == Power and authority == f5d7d52911 Although the force was originally formed under the Harbour, Docks and Piers Clauses Act 1847, the current authority derives from Tees and Hartlepool Port Authority Act 1966, with constables' jurisdictions extending to two miles beyond the harbour. Under the Act, the harbour police have ‘all the powers and privileges, and shall be entitled to the indemnities and protection, of a constable within the harbour and in any place not more than two miles beyond the limits of the harbour’. f5d7d52911
