Simultaneous game For example, in a two player continuous game that is sequential, the second player can act in response to the action taken by the first player. dominant strategy provides a player with the highest possible payoff for any strategy of the other players. Normal form representations are usually used for simultaneous games. Simultaneous games contrast with sequential games, which are played by the players taking turns (moves alternate between players). Even if the players do not act at the same time, both players are uninformed of each other's move while making their decisions. In other words, both players normally act at the same time in a simultaneous game. However, this is not possible in a simultaneous game where both players act at the same time. Given a continuous game, players will have different information sets if the game is simultaneous than if it is sequential because they have less information to act on at each step in the game. Life history theory A life history strategy is the "age- and stage-specific patterns" and timing of events that make up an organism's life, such as birth, weaning, maturation, death, etc. These events, notably juvenile development, age of sexual maturity, first reproduction, number of offspring and level of parental investment, senescence and death, depend on the physical and ecological environment of the organism. adapt and thereby achieve an "optimal" life history strategy that allows the highest level of fitness possible (fitness maximization). It is a theory of biological evolution that seeks to explain aspects of organisms' anatomy and behavior by reference to the way that their life histories—including their reproductive development and behaviors, post-reproductive behaviors, and lifespan (length of time alive)—have been shaped by natural selection. Speculation about inhabited worlds beyond Earth dates back to antiquity. Early Christian writers, including Augustine, discussed ideas from thinkers like Democritus and Epicurus about countless worlds in the vast universe. Pre-modern writers typically assumed extraterrestrial "worlds" were inhabited by living beings. William Vorilong, in the 15th century, acknowledged the possibility Jesus could have visited extraterrestrial worlds to redeem their inhabitants. In 1440, Nicholas of Cusa suggested Earth is a "brilliant star"; he theorized that all celestial bodies, even the Sun, could host life. Life expectancy mortality. Period LEB is the mean length of life of a hypothetical cohort assumed to be exposed, from birth through death, to the mortality rates observed at a given year. National LEB figures reported by national agencies and international organizations for human populations are estimates of period LEB. The

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most commonly used measure is life expectancy at birth (LEB, or in demographic notation e_0 , where e_x denotes the average life remaining at age x). This can be defined in two ways. Cohort LEB is the mean length of life of a birth cohort (in this case, all individuals born in a given year) and can be computed only for cohorts born so long ago that all their members have died. English life expectancy at birth averaged about 36 years in the 17th and 18th centuries, one of the highest levels in the world although infant Human life expectancy is a statistical measure of the estimate of the average remaining years of life at a given age 1ab27011d1

End-of-life care is most commonly provided at home, in a hospital, or in a long-term care facility with care being provided by family members, nurses, social workers, physicians, and other support staff. Facilities may also have palliative or hospice care teams that will provide end-of-life care services.
