Without this ligament, the tendon of the biceps brachii would be liable to pull the head of the radius out of the joint. a2522bbc4c Characteristic signs include pain, swelling, and ecchymosis around the thenar eminence, and especially over the MCP joint of the thumb. Sprain Ulnar collateral ligament injury of the elbow are commonly caused A sprain is a soft tissue injury of the ligaments within a joint, often caused by a sudden movement abruptly forcing the joint to exceed its functional range of motion. Elbow – Sprains occur when one or more ligaments around the elbow are torn or stretched. An equivalent injury to a muscle or tendon is known as a strain. Sprains may be mild (first degree), moderate (second degree), or severe (third degree), with the latter two classes involving some degree of tearing of the ligament. Ligaments are tough, inelastic fibers made of collagen that connect two or more bones to form a joint and are important for joint stability and proprioception, which is the body's sense of limb position and movement. Sprains can occur at any joint but most commonly occur in the ankle, knee, or wrist a2522bbc4c

The capitulum occupies only the anterior and inferior surfaces of the lower end of the humerus, so that in complete extension a part of the radial head can be plainly felt projecting at the back of the joint. a2522bbc4c Gingery attended Marina High School in Huntington Beach, California. As a

Elbow The elbow joint is a hinge joint between the arm and the forearm; more specifically between the humerus in the upper arm and the radius and ulna in the forearm which allows the forearm and hand to be moved towards and away from the body. The elbow includes prominent landmarks such as the olecranon, the cubital fossa (also called the chelidon, or the elbow pit), and the lateral and the medial epicondyles of the humerus. Less distinct than the ulnar collateral ligament, this ligament blends with the annular ligament of the radius and its margins are attached The elbow is the region between the upper arm and the forearm that surrounds the elbow joint. extensor tendon a2522bbc4c

== Structure == a2522bbc4c The annular ligament binds the head of the radius to the radial notch of the ulna, preventing any separation of the two bones laterally.
