He began studying philosophy at the University of Zaragoza, later earning his licentiate degree and doctoral degree from the University of Madrid. His PhD dissertation, supervised by Santiago Montero Díaz, was titled *Fundamento formal y material de la moderna filosofía de la religión* ('Formal and material foundation of the modern philosophy of religion'). From 1949 to 1960, he worked as a philosophy teacher (and from 1951 onwards as headmaster) at the 'Lucía Medrano' girls' high school in Salamanca. He continued his studies at the Ludwig-Maximilians-Universität München, the University of Zurich, and the University of Paris. However, during the 1930s, he left the Church and pursued philosophy at the University of Barcelona. In 1936 after criticizing Francisco Franco, Bacca was forced to live in exile. He first traveled to Ecuador where he taught at the Central University of Ecuador

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from 1939 to 1942. While in Ecuador, he became close friends with a writer named Alfredo Pareja Diezcanseco. He then went to Mexico where he taught at the National Autonomous University of Mexico (UNAM - Universidad Nacional Autónoma de México) from 1942 to 1946. He eventually established himself in Venezuela in 1946 and was granted citizenship in 1952. Bacca was a professor at the Central University of Venezuela until his retirement in 1971. He was recognized for his life's work and was awarded the National Prize for Literature in 1978. c7208a5cb1

Mujica was born in Avellaneda, a neighborhood near the city of Buenos Aires, to an anarchist syndicalist father. As his father became blind after a work accident when Mujica was only thirteen years of age, he began to work in a glass factory, continuing with high school at night school. At the same time he pursued studies in Fine Arts. Amidst the fervour of the sixties he settled in Greenwich Village, New York. There he began to study philosophy at the experimental Free University of New York, and resumed painting at School of Visual Arts. He was an active painter until the final years of the sixties when, following his own account, 'painting left me'. c7208a5cb1 In his book A Critique of Affirmative Morality (A

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reflection on Death, Birth and the Value of Life), Julio Cabrera presents his theory about the value of human existence. Human life, for Cabrera, is "structurally negative" insofar as there are negative components of life that are inevitable, constitutive and adverse: as prominent among them Cabrera cites loss, scarcity, pain, conflicts, fragility, illness, aging, discouragement and death. According to Cabrera they form the basic structure to human life, which he analyzes through what he calls naturalistic phenomenology, drawing freely from thinkers such as Martin Heidegger, Arthur Schopenhauer... c7208a5cb1

Santiago Genovés The 101-day experiment, frequently dubbed the "Sex Raft" by the media, was the subject of the 2018 documentary film *The Raft*, by Marcus Lindeen. He is best remembered for the 1973 "Peace Project" experiment that he designed, in which he and ten other people (four men and six women) aimed to sail on the Acali raft from the Canary Islands, a Spanish archipelago in Africa, to Cozumel island, Mexico. He hoped that this

experiment would shed light on the causes of violence in humans and on how it could be prevented. 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A student of the national-syndicalist Santiago Montero Díaz, Bueno's philosophical trajectory culminated in a blend of Aristotelian-Thomist scholasticism—influenced by the Catholic School of Salamanca—and Marxism-Leninism during the late years of Francoism. c7208a5cb1 A variant of the ideology focuses specifically on projects of Hispanic American unity (the Patria Grande), to the exclusion of Hispanic areas outside the Americas. c7208a5cb1 Panhispanism is notably characterized by its history of adaptation to all sides of the political spectrum while retaining its core tenet of Hispanic unity and its anti-Americanism. It has been present consistently in literature, revolutionary movements, and political institutions. c7208a5cb1 He briefly experimented with marijuana and LSD, part of the scene in those days. He briefly met Ralph Metzner, who helped to publish one of his drawings. He was irreligious most of his young years, but that changed with his encounter

with Swami Satchidananda. He converted to Catholicism when contemplating monastic life. He read Classical Philology at Salamanca University, being one of the first students of Spanish philologist Antonio Tovar. He concluded his doctoral dissertation on Ancient prosody and metrics in Madrid at the age of 22. In 1951, he worked as a grammar-school teacher. In 1953 he was appointed to a university chair of Classical Languages in Seville, and he occupied a second chair at Madrid's Universidad Complutense (then called "Central University of Madrid") from 1964 to 1965. In 1965 the Franco administration expelled him from his Madrid chair, along with Enrique Tierno Galván, José Luis López Aranguren and Santiago Montero Díaz, because they had given support to student protests against the fascist government. José María Valverde and Antonio Tovar resigned from their university chairs as a sign of protest against this reprisal. García Calvo spent many years of his subsequent exile in Paris, being appointed professor at Lille University and at the Collège de France.
