The tradition of a summer encampment began in 1878, six years after the Bohemian Club was founded in 1872. That year, founding member and stage actor Henry "Harry" Edwards announced that he was moving to New York City to further his career. On June 29, 1878, fewer than 100 Bohemians gathered in the redwoods of Marin County near Taylorville (present-day Samuel P. Taylor State Park) for an evening send-off held in his honor.
