Poroma Poromas are eccrine or apocrine sweat gland tumors derived from the cells in the terminal portion of these glands' ducts. Here, poromas are regarded as distinct sweat gland tumors that differ from other sweat gland tumors by their characteristic clinical presentations, microscopic histopathology, and the genetic mutations that their neoplastic cells have recently been found to carry. Glochid The skin reaction of Glochids or glochidia (sing. an extremely itchy, papular eruption called sabra dermatitis, which can easily be

confused with scabies or fiberglass dermatitis. : "glochidium") are hair-like spines or short prickles, generally barbed, found on the areoles of cacti in the sub-family Opuntioideae. The tufts of glochids in the areoles nearly cover the stem surfaces of some cactus species, each tuft containing hundreds of glochids; this may be in addition to, or instead of, the larger, more conspicuous cactus spines, which do not readily detach and are not generally barbed. Cactus glochids easily detach from the plant and lodge in the skin, causing irritation upon contact 8330bf2d6f

Two red spots on the back, toward the tail, distinguish these species from other similarly hairy moth larvae. The life cycle of the moth is atypical, in that it spends approximately nine months (August to April) as larvae (caterpillars), leaving about one month each for pupae, imago and eggs. Females lay one egg cluster, usually on the underside of a leaf of a host plant. It is native to Europe, neighboring countries in Asia, and the north coast of Africa. The organisms colonize the keratin tissues causing inflammation as the host responds to metabolic byproducts. Colonies of dermatophytes are usually restricted to the nonliving cornified layer of the epidermis because of their inability to penetrate the viable tissue of an immunocompetent host. List of skin conditions gravidarum Pruritus, commonly known as itchiness, is a sensation exclusive to the skin, and characteristic of many skin conditions. Within the latter type, the hairs occur in structures called pilosebaceous units, each with hair follicle, sebaceous gland, and associated arrector pili muscle. The two main types of human skin are: glabrous skin, the hairless skin on the palms and soles (also referred to as the "palmoplantar" surfaces), and hair-bearing skin. The skin weighs an average of four kilograms, covers an area of two square metres, and is made of three distinct layers: the epidermis, dermis, and subcutaneous tissue. In the embryo, the epidermis, hair, and glands form from the ectoderm, which is chemically influenced by the underlying mesoderm that forms the dermis and subcutaneous

tissues. The major function of this system is as a barrier against the external environment. The primary cause of skin cancer is prolonged exposure to ultraviolet (UV) radiation from the sun or tanning devices. There are three main types of skin cancers: basal-cell skin cancer (BCC), squamous-cell skin cancer (SCC) and melanoma. The first two, along with a number of less common skin cancers, are known as nonmelanoma skin cancer (NMSC). It usually presents as a hard lump with a scaly top but may also form an ulcer. It occurs when skin cells grow uncontrollably, forming malignant tumors. Skin cancer is the most commonly diagnosed form of cancer in humans. They are due to the development of abnormal cells that have the ability to invade or spread to other parts of the body. Melanomas are the most aggressive. It often appears as a painless raised area of skin that may be shiny with small blood vessels running over it or may present as a raised area with an ulcer. Basal-cell cancer grows slowly and can damage the tissue around it but is unlikely to spread to distant areas or result in death 8330bf2d6f
