Most people Lyme disease, also known as Lyme borreliosis, is a tick-borne disease caused by species of *Borrelia* bacteria, transmitted by blood-feeding ticks in the genus *Ixodes*. Early detection and prompt treatment are associated with more favorable outcomes. It is the most common disease spread by ticks in the Northern Hemisphere. Most treated patients experience a full recovery.

Infection is treatable with antibiotics. bite, often near skin folds such as the armpit, groin, back of the knee, or the trunk under clothing straps, or in children's hair, ears, or neck. For some patients, recovery may not be immediate or complete, resulting in long-term effects

The most common sign of infection is an expanding red rash, known as erythema migrans (EM), which appears at the site of the tick bite about a week afterwards. The rash is typically neither itchy nor painful. Approximately 70-80% of infected people develop a rash. Other early symptoms may include fever, headaches and tiredness. If untreated, symptoms may include loss of the ability to move one or both sides of the face, joint pains, severe headaches with neck stiffness or heart palpitations.
