Watch straps may close with a buckle or a folding clasp. In American English, the term "cleats" is used synecdochically to refer to shoes featuring such protrusions. In British English the more common term for sports shoes with cleats or studs is boots, especially when referring to particular sports (e.g. Football boots, Rugby boots etc.). The chain tool has two positions where a chain can be inserted perpendicular to the tool, one close to the movable screw portion, and one lower down just above the fixed end. In each position, there are a pair of protruding tabs; one fits into the center of one link of the chain, the other fits into the center of the next link. With the chain properly in place, the pin is held in the center of the tool, so that the tip of the movable screw can press on the end of the pin. The end of the screw is slightly narrower than the pin, so that... Uneven or accelerated tire wear: can be caused by under-inflation, overloading or poor wheel alignment. The simple term "ear piercing" usually refers to an earlobe piercing, whereas piercings in the upper part of the external ear are often referred to as "cartilage piercings". Cartilage piercings are more complex to perform than earlobe piercings and take longer to heal. 1dae02c01c Both tools can also be used to clean up or repair a thread, which is called chasing. However using an ordinary tap or die to clean threads generally removes some material, which results in looser, weaker threads. Because of this, machinists generally clean threads with special taps and dies—called chasers—made for that purpose. Chasers are made of softer materials and don't cut new threads. However they still fit tighter than actual fasteners, and are fluted like regular taps and dies so debris can escape. Car mechanics, for example, use chasers on spark plug threads, to remove corrosion and carbon build-up. 1dae02c01c

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
