Australian bat lyssavirus It was first identified in a 5-month-old juvenile black flying fox (*Pteropus alecto*) collected near Ballina in northern New South Wales, Australia, in January 1995 during a national surveillance program for the recently

identified Hendra virus. the virus. After a 27-month incubation, a rabies-like illness Australian bat lyssavirus (ABLV) is an enzootic virus closely related to the rabies virus. Post-exposure prophylaxis was advised, but for an unknown reason she declined the treatment. ABLV is the seventh member of the genus Lyssavirus (which includes rabies virus) and the only Lyssavirus member present in Australia. ABLV has been categorised to the Phylogroup I of the Lyssaviruses

Early symptoms can include fever and abnormal sensations at the site of exposure, which are followed by nausea, vomiting, violent movements, uncontrolled excitement, fear of water, inability to move parts of the body, confusion, and loss of consciousness. For example, the term hydrophobia is an old name for rabies, since an aversion to water is one of that disease's symptoms. than true phobias. Those affected go to great lengths to avoid the situation or object, to a degree greater than the actual danger posed. If the object or situation cannot be avoided, they experience significant distress. Other symptoms can include fainting, which may occur in blood or injury phobia, and panic attacks, often found in agoraphobia and emetophobia. Rabies is caused by lyssaviruses, including the rabies virus and Australian bat lyssavirus. It is spread when an infected animal bites or scratches a human or other animals. Even in the absence of a bite or a scratch, saliva from an infected animal coming into contact with the eyes, mouth, or nose can transmit rabies. Rabies can also be transmitted through tears and nervous tissues. Globally, dogs are the most common animal involved. In 2025, the SCORPIO-PEP trial found the treatment with ensitrelvir significantly reduced the incidence of symptomatic COVID-19 in people who had a household exposure to the illness compared to a placebo. In clinical observations, only 2.9% of the ensitrelvir group developed symptoms, versus 9.0% in the control group, representing a 67% reduction in risk. In September 2025, the FDA accepted a New Drug Application from the manufacturer for ensitrelvir as PEP for... 323461f085 Rabies vaccines may be used safely by all age groups. inflammation (encephalitis). Subsequent simian-acquired
infections with this virus have occurred with mortality rate as
high as 80%. Currently, transmission of the virus through a
monkey bite almost always is the result of an occupational

infection presents with] herpetic skin lesions and sensory
changes [are visible] near the exposure site, fever and

into the skin or muscle. After exposure, the vaccination is

typically used along with rabies immunoglobulin. It is recommended that those who are at high risk of exposure be vaccinated before potential exposure. Rabies vaccines are effective in humans and other animals, and vaccinating dogs is very effective in preventing the spread of rabies to humans. A long-lasting immunity to the virus develops after a full course of treatment. 323461f085
