The endocrine functionality of the pancreas is provided by islet cells which produce the hormones insulin and glucagon. Artificial pancreatic technology mimics the secretion of these hormones into the bloodstream in response to the body's changing blood glucose levels. Maintaining balanced blood sugar levels is crucial to the function of the brain, liver, and kidneys. Therefore, for people with diabetes, it is necessary that the levels be kept balanced when the body cannot produce insulin itself. Automated insulin delivery (AID) systems are often referred to using the term artificial pancreas, but the term has no precise, universally... Inflammation of the pancreas is known as pancreatitis; common causes include chronic alcohol use and gallstones. Automated insulin delivery system something closer to the endocrine functionality of the pancreas. Other systems currently in development aim to improve on current systems by adding one or more additional hormones that can be delivered as needed, providing something closer to the endocrine functionality of the pancreas
