== Route description == bb2389258a == Route description == bb2389258a The road runs south to north through Barrio Machuelo Arriba, where it serves as the main access to several communities and neighborhood developments before leaving the city of Ponce to the mountains. Then, the road makes its way through the rural area, mostly alongside Río Cerrillos in barrio Maragüez, bordering the western bank of Lake Cerrillos until it reaches upstream of the reservoir, where it crosses the river and makes its way along its eastern bank. Farther north, PR-139 climbs the mountains of the Cordillera Central through Barrio Anón until its terminus at the Ruta Panorámica. bb2389258a

It is the main highway to Moca and San Sebastián, being a two-lane highway before turning rural on its way to Lares, where it meets PR-129, which taking north goes to Arecibo and meets PR-2 and PR-22. In Lares, it becomes a divided avenue, replacing an old, narrow segment, but then becomes rural again. It continues to Utuado, crossing PR-10, and merging shortly with PR-123. It ends at PR-140 east of Utuado, near Jayuya. It is one of two long highways going west-east through the center of Puerto Rico (the other being PR-156). It is named the Carretera Enrique Laguerre through all its length. bb2389258a

Puerto Rico Highway 3 Highway 3 ranges from a three lane urban avenue in San Juan to a one lane rural road past Fajardo. Puerto Rico Highway 3 (PR-3) at nearly 100 miles long, is the second-longest highway on Puerto Rico (after PR-2). While other roads connect San Juan, it runs the coastline of Puerto Rico east of San Juan, beginning in Río Piedras near Santurce (where it is known as the Avenida 65 de Infantería) and goes to Fajardo where it goes south paralleling the coastline to Humacao and Maunabo. It connects the San Juan neighborhood Puerto Rico Highway 3 (PR-3) at nearly 100 miles long, is the second-longest highway on Puerto Rico (after PR-2). It goes up to a mountain-scenic route and goes west to Salinas, where it meets PR-1. It connects the San Juan neighborhood of Río Piedras to downtown Salinas indirectly around the eastern coast of the island bb2389258a

It is the main route to Guánica and Lajas, and grants access to places such as the Dry Forest of Puerto Rico (Bosque Seco), common for its cacti and dry, desert-like climate, and also to beaches like Parguera in Lajas and Playa Santa in Guánica. It is divided, two lane-per-direction in the first 4 kilometers before turning one lane-per direction in the rest of its length.
