The majority of the population fall within three large linguistic groups: Indo-Aryan, Dravidian, and Iranian. These groups are also further subdivided into numerous sub-groups, castes and tribes. Indo-Aryans form the predominant ethnolinguistic group in India (North India, East India, West India, and Central India), Bangladesh, Pakistan, Nepal, Sri Lanka, and the Maldives. Dravidians form the predominant ethnolinguistic group in southern India, the northern and eastern regions of Sri Lanka and a small pocket of Pakistan. The Iranian peoples also have a significant presence in South Asia, the large majority of whom are located in Afghanistan and the northwestern and western parts of Pakistan. The "major national ethnic races" are grouped primarily according to geographic region rather than ethnolinguistic affiliation. For example, the Shan national race includes 33 ethnic groups that live in Shan State and speak languages in at least four language families. Ethnicities are maintained through long-term endogamy and may have a narrow or broad spectrum of genetic ancestry, with some groups having mixed genetic ancestry. Ethnicity is sometimes used interchangeably with nation. Attributes that ethnicities believe to share include language, culture, common sets of ancestry, traditions, society, religion, history, or social treatment

Minor categories include Aimaqs, Turkmens, Balochs, Nuristanis, and Arabs, among others. However, the boundaries between these communities are fluid, with language, self-identification, urban or rural residence, and regional affiliations intersecting in complex ways. In more recent history, a number of immigrants from other countries have made their home in Japan. In 2018, 97.8% of the population of Japan were Japanese citizens, with the remainder being foreign nationals residing in Japan. The number of foreign workers has been increasing dramatically in recent years, due to the aging population and the lack of labor force. A 2018 article stated that approximately 1 out of 10 young people residing in Tokyo were foreign nationals.

There are in addition small distinct ethnic groups that have been classified as part of larger ethnic groups that are officially recognized. Han Chinese, being the world's largest ethnic group, has great diversity within it. Some groups, like the Hui of Xinjiang with the Hui of Fujian, are geographically and culturally separate, except for the shared belief of Islam. Taken together, these groups (simplified Chinese: 维族; traditional Chinese: 維族; pinyin: wèi shíbié mínzú) would constitute the twentieth most populous ethnic group of China.
