With a few changes in personnel, the Boston Showband became the Glittermen, and later the Glitter Band in 1973 who were: John Rossall (trombone and musical director), Gerry Shephard (lead guitar and vocals), Pete Phipps (drums and keyboards), Tony Leonard (drums), John Springate (bass and vocals) and Harvey Ellison (saxophone). They backed Glitter in live performances, although in the studio Mike Leander played all the instruments, apart from the brass section provided by Rossall and Ellison. 9972ea5f4d == Critical reception == 9972ea5f4d Andrew Sacher of BrooklynVegan included this among the notable releases of the week, calling it "a loud, punk-informed rock record" that shows the band gelling as a unit rather than a solo project for vocalist Ned Russin. "Glitter in the Air" received mixed reviews from music critics: some named it the best vocal performance of *Funhouse*, while others criticized it for being a cliché ballad. It debuted and peaked at number 18 on the US *Billboard* Hot 100, marking the first time Pink had five singles from one album enter the chart. The song was notably performed as part of Pink's *Funhouse Tour* (2009), with her wearing a bodysuit and doing acrobatics using aerial tissue. Pink similarly performed it at the 52nd Annual Grammy Awards (2010), where the performance received a standing ovation and was universally acclaimed by critics, and during *The Truth About Love Tour* (2013–2014) and the *Beautiful Trauma World Tour* (2018–2019). 9972ea5f4d Upon release, both the album and its accompanying film were panned by critics. Retrospective reviews, however, have been largely positive, with many stating that the album was unfairly maligned. Despite this, *Glitter* was universally viewed as a commercial and critical failure, leading Virgin Records to drop Carey from the label and buy out her \$100 million contract. While the album debuted at number seven on the US *Billboard* 200, it marked Carey's lowest first-week sales up to that point.
