People living in rural areas also tend to have less education, lower socioeconomic status, and higher rates of alcohol and smoking when compared to their urban counterparts. Additionally, the rate of poverty is higher in rural populations globally, contributing to health... 04465c5b10 RUCA codes are based on central place theory, which highlight the link between larger cities (providing more specialized goods and services as well more jobs), smaller cities (with more limited availability of goods and services and fewer jobs), and rural areas (where residents must travel to a closer city to obtain goods and services). RUCA codes take into account both the degree of urbanization and commuting flows to categorize a census tract within the rural-urban hierarchy. RUCA codes derive from the standard Census Bureau urban area definitions but are extended to the census tract level to provide greater geographic detail. 04465c5b10 Rural areas have unique economic and social dynamics due to their relationship with land-based industry such as agriculture, forestry, and resource extraction. Rural economics can be subject to boom and bust cycles and vulnerable to extreme weather or natural disasters, such as droughts. These dynamics alongside larger economic forces encouraging urbanization have led to significant demographic declines, called rural flight, where economic incentives encourage younger populations to go to cities for education and access to jobs, leaving older, less educated, and less wealthy populations in the rural areas. Slower economic development can result in poorer services like healthcare, education, and infrastructure. Much support for the introduction of a nationwide rural mail delivery service came from The National Grange of the Order of Patrons of Husbandry, the United States' oldest agricultural organization. Formerly, residents of rural areas had to either travel to a distant post office to pick up their mail, or else pay for delivery by a private carrier. Free mail delivery began in American cities in 1863 with a limited scope. Shortly afterwards, rural citizens began petitioning for equal consideration.
