The recording was made from Dallas Police Radio Channel 1, which carried routine police radio traffic. Channel 2 was reserved for special events such as the presidential motorcade. The open-microphone portion of the recording lasts 5.5 minutes and begins at about 12:29 p.m. local time, a minute before the assassination. During firing, the bullet passes through the bore with little hindrance, but most of the expanding gas ejecta behind it is redirected through a longer and convoluted escape path created by the baffles, prolonging the release time.
