Language Spoken at Home After the long Language Spoken at Home is a data set published by the United States Census Bureau on languages in the United States. The third part of the question asks how well the person speaks English ("Very well", "Well", "not well", "Not at all"). The first part asks if the person speaks a language other than English at home. If the answer is "yes", the respondent is asked what that language is. It is based on a three-part language question asked about all household members who are five years old or older. The Woccon are believed to have been decimated as a people during the Tuscarora War in the Carolinas with English colonists in 1713. Survivors were likely absorbed into the Tuscarora, an Iroquoian-speaking people, who subsequently migrated north to New York, settling with the five nations of the Haudenosaunee Confederacy by 1722 and being accepted as the sixth. Under these pressures, the Woccon language is believed to have become extinct in the eighteenth century.
