Malignant acrospiroma can develop de novo or from a pre-existing benign lesion. 9f653243ee Survival after diagnosis of amelanotic melanoma was found in a 2014 seven-year study of 3,000 patients to be poorer than for pigmented melanoma, which was attributed to the more advanced stage at diagnosis due probably to difficulty of diagnosis. Nodular melanoma Instead of arising from a pre-existing mole, it may appear in a spot where a lesion did not previously exist. A light-colored or non-pigmented NM lesion may escape detection because the appearance is not alarming, however an ulcerated and/or bleeding lesion is common. It tends to grow more rapidly in thickness (vertically penetrate the skin) than in diameter

Nodular melanoma (NM) is the most aggressive form of melanoma. It tends to grow more rapidly in thickness (vertically penetrate the skin) than in diameter compared to other melanoma subtypes. Nodular melanoma (NM) is the most aggressive form of melanoma. NM is most often darkly pigmented; however, some NM lesions can be light brown, multicolored or even colorless (non-pigmented). Since NM tends to grow in depth more quickly than it does in width, and can occur in a place that did not have a previous lesion, the prognosis is often worse because it takes longer for a person to be aware of the changes.
