These travelers sought the free-roaming cattle herds multiplying in the southern pampas and hunted indigenous peoples to enslave them. Many settled in the area, becoming ranchers and small-scale farmers. Due to its coastal hills, the area was

soon recognized for its strategic value as a vantage point for observation and control, holding military and political significance in the...
