Lymph node metastasis is different from lymphoma. Lymphoma is a cancer of lymph node, rather than cancer in the lymph node, because lymphoma originates from the lymph node itself, instead of originating elsewhere (e.g., the breast or colon) and spreading to the lymph nodes.

088c0664ce When the duct ruptures, the resulting flood of liquid into the pleural cavity is known as chylothorax.

088c0664ce Functionally, the bronchomediastinal lymph trunks are pivotal in transporting lymph, which includes lymphocytes and other immune cells, from the thorax to the bloodstream. This process is crucial for immune surveillance and maintaining fluid balance within the body. Clinically, these trunks are significant for their role in the potential spread of diseases, particularly thoracic cancers, making them important landmarks in oncological diagnostics and treatment planning.

Structure == 088c0664ce The sentinel lymph node is the hypothetical first lymph node (or group of nodes) to which metastasizing cancer cells are likely to spread from the tumor origin site. Identification of the sentinel lymph node(s) following a cancer diagnosis helps assess the extent of metastasis and guide the development of an appropriate treatment plan. 088c0664ce Located in the mediastinum, the central part of the thoracic cavity, these trunks form from the convergence of efferent vessels that ascend along the trachea. Typically, there are two trunks - one on each side of the body. The right bronchomediastinal trunk may connect the right lymphatic duct, and the left trunk to the thoracic duct, although more frequently, they open independently into the junction of the internal jugular vein and subclavian veins on their respective sides. 088c0664ce

The lymphatic system is part of the immune surveillance system. Blood contains fluid and blood cells. The fluid, which may contain suspended foreign material such as bacteria and viruses, seeps through blood vessel walls into the tissues, where it bathes the body cells and exchanges substances with them. Some of this lymph fluid is then taken up by lymphatic vessels and passed back to the heart, where it is again mixed with the blood. On its way, the fluid passes through the lymph

Lymph nodes become inflamed or enlarged in various diseases, which may range from mild throat infections to life-threatening cancers. The condition of lymph nodes is very important in cancer staging, which decides the treatment to be used and determines the prognosis. Lymphadenopathy refers to glands that are enlarged or swollen. When inflamed or enlarged, lymph nodes can be firm or tender. The major concern with micrometastases is that the only way to determine if they are present in distant tissue is to remove cells from where they are located and look at slices of the tissue under the microscope. Lymph originates in the interstitial fluid that leaks from blood in the circulatory system into the tissues of the body. This fluid carries nutrients to the cells and collects waste products, bacteria, and damaged cells, before draining into the lymphatic vessels as lymph. The circulatory system processes an average of 20 litres (5.3 US gal) of blood per day through capillary filtration, which removes plasma from the blood. Roughly 17 litres (4.5 US gal) of the filtered blood is reabsorbed directly into the blood vessels, while the remaining 3 litres (0.79 US gal) are left in the interstitial fluid. The lymphatic system provides an accessory return route to the blood for this remainder.

The sentinel node procedure (also termed sentinel lymph node biopsy or SLNB) involves identifying, removing, and analyzing the sentinel lymph nodes associated with a particular tumor. In SLNB, a tracer material—often a blue dye or a radioactive substance—is injected near the tumor site.

The tracer travels to the first drainage site, allowing the surgeon to locate the sentinel nodes. After identification, the sentinel nodes are removed and sent for laboratory testing to determine the presence of cancer cells. 088c0664ce In adults, the thoracic duct is typically 38–45 cm in length and has an

Thoracic duct Deep lymph nodes and In human anatomy, the thoracic duct (also known as the left lymphatic duct, alimentary duct, chyliferous duct, and Van Hoorne's duct) is the larger of the two lymph ducts of the lymphatic system (the other being the right lymphatic duct). The arch of the aorta, and its branches. The thoracic duct usually begins from the upper aspect of the cisterna chyli, passing out of the abdomen through the aortic hiatus into first the posterior mediastinum and then the superior mediastinum, extending as high up as the root of the neck before descending to drain into the systemic (blood) circulation at the venous angle. Neck The muscles of the neck, which are separate from the compartments, form the boundaries of the neck triangles.

Anatomically, the human neck is divided into four compartments: vertebral, visceral, and two vascular compartments. Additionally, the neck is highly flexible, allowing the head to turn and move in all directions. Within these compartments, the neck houses the cervical vertebrae, the cervical portion of the spinal cord, upper parts of the respiratory and digestive tracts, endocrine glands, nerves, arteries and veins. Micrometastasis Micrometastases are too few in size and quantity to be picked up in a screening or diagnostic test, and therefore cannot be seen with imaging tests such as a mammogram, MRI, ultrasound, PET, or CT scans. lymph nodes in addition to the SLN. Each woman has a different number of lymph nodes in her body, so determining how many nodes to remove is based on A micrometastasis is a small collection of cancer cells that has been shed from the original tumor and spread to another part of the body through the lymphovascular system. These migrant cancer cells may group together to form a second tumor, which is so small that it can only be seen under a microscope. It is important for these cancer cells to be treated immediately after discovery, in order to prevent the relapse (regrowth of the cancer) and the likely death of the patient.
