"Mushroom" also describes a variety of other gilled fungi, with or without stems; therefore the term is used to describe the fleshy fruiting bodies of some Ascomycota. In some jurisdictions, Psilocybe spores are legal to sell and possess, because they contain neither psilocybin nor psilocin. In other jurisdictions, they are

Legal status of psilocybin mushrooms However, psilocybin mushrooms have had numerous medicinal and religious uses in dozens of cultures throughout history and have a significantly lower potential for abuse than other Schedule I drugs. Psilocybin mushrooms are not regulated by UN treaties. Psilocybin and psilocin are listed as Schedule I drugs under the United Nations 1971 Convention on Psychotropic Substances. Many countries, however, have some level of regulation or prohibition of psilocybin mushrooms (for example The legal status of unauthorised actions with psilocybin mushrooms varies worldwide. Schedule I drugs are defined as drugs with a high potential for abuse or drugs that have no recognized medical uses 15d4c46ade

deciduous trees, especially maples. Lingzhi may be cultivated on hardwood logs, sawdust, or woodchips. These are larger works that may be hard to take on a hike but help with in depth identification after mushroom hunting. The fungus was first described scientifically as *Agaricus edodes* by Miles Joseph Berkeley in 1877. It was placed in the genus *Lentinula* by David Pegler in 1976. The fungus has acquired an extensive synonymy in its taxonomic history:

Psilocybin mushroom Rather than referring to one single mushroom species, the term "psilocybin mushroom" refers to a broad group of fungi found across several genera. The most potent species are members of genus *Psilocybe*, such as *P. semilanceata*, and *P. azurescens*, *P. modify* the effects of magic mushrooms. Other compounds such as baeocystin, norbaeocystin, aeruginascin, and β -carboline may modulate effects. *cyanescens*, but psilocybin has also been isolated from approximately a dozen other genera, including *Panaeolus* (including *Copelandia*), *Inocybe*, *Pluteus*, *Gymnopilus*, and *Pholiotina*. Animal studies suggest that the effects of pure psilocybin or psilocin and psilocybin mushrooms may be different and **Psilocybin mushroom**

is a type of hallucinogenic mushroom and a polyphyletic informal group of fungi that contain the prodrug psilocybin, which is metabolised into the psychedelic compound psilocin following ingestion 15d4c46ade

Identification guides Regulation Ingestion of the mushroom can cause poisoning, especially in children and those seeking its hallucinogenic effects, due to psychoactive compounds like muscimol and ibotenic acid; however, fatal poisonings are extremely rare. Parboiling reduces toxicity; drying converts ibotenic acid into muscimol while retaining psychoactive effects. Some cultures use it as food after preparation. Indigenous peoples of Siberia used *A. muscaria* as an inebriant and entheogen. It has been controversially...

Lingzhi, also known as reishi from its Japanese pronunciation, is the ancient "mushroom of immortality", revered for over 2,000 years (with some evidence suggesting use in Neolithic China 6,800 years ago). However, as of 2023 there is an ongoing debate on which one of the described *Ganoderma* species is the true lingzhi mushroom.
