Tuberculosis vaccines Immunotherapy as a defence against TB was first proposed in 1890 by Robert Koch. It is recommended for babies in countries where tuberculosis is common. As of 2021, the only effective tuberculosis vaccine in common use is the Bacillus Calmette-Guérin (BCG) vaccine, first used on humans in 1921. Childhood immunizations in the United States Childhood immunization in the US has been affected by recurring vaccine hesitancy and anti-vaccine activism, including concerns about vaccine safety, vaccine ingredients, and the number and timing of recommended vaccines. The schedule includes vaccines of several different types against viral and bacterial infections including hepatitis B, rotavirus, diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, Haemophilus influenzae type b, pneumococcal disease, polio, influenza, varicella, hepatitis A, measles, mumps, rubella, meningococcal disease, and human papillomavirus. Routine childhood vaccination in the US was disrupted during the COVID-19 pandemic, but immunization rates returned to near pre-pandemic levels by 2024. The childhood vaccine schedule is designed specifically to deliver protection during periods of greatest vulnerability. Most of the common side effects are minor and are self-resolving Spinal anaesthesia (or spinal anesthesia), also called spinal block, subarachnoid block, intradural block and intrathecal block, is a form of neuraxial regional anaesthesia involving the injection of a local anaesthetic with or without an opioid into the subarachnoid space. It is a safe and effective form of anesthesia usually performed by anesthesiologists that can be used as an alternative to general anesthesia commonly in surgeries involving the lower extremities and surgeries below the umbilicus 9705f6834b

The most common sign of infection is an expanding red rash, known as erythema migrans (EM), which appears at the site of the tick bite about a week afterwards. The rash is typically neither itchy nor painful. Approximately 70-80% of infected people develop a rash. Other early symptoms may include fever, headaches and tiredness. If untreated, symptoms may include loss of the ability to move one or both sides of the face, joint pains, severe headaches with neck stiffness or heart palpitations. MMR vaccine It contains the combined measles vaccine, mumps vaccine, and rubella vaccine into a single injection. The vaccine is also recommended for those who do not have evidence of immunity, those with well-controlled HIV/AIDS, and within 72 hours of exposure to measles among those who are incompletely immunized. Side effects of immunization are generally mild and resolve without any specific treatment The MMR vaccine (abbreviated as MMR) is a combination vaccine against measles, mumps, and rubella (German measles). It is given by injection. After two doses, 97% of people are protected against measles, 88% against mumps, and at least 97% against rubella. Between 2000 and 2018, vaccination decreased measles deaths by 73% 9705f6834b

The World Health Organization (WHO) recommends routine vaccination only if a country can keep more than 80% of people vaccinated. If only 20% to 80% of people are vaccinated it is possible that more people will get the disease at an older age and outcomes overall may worsen. Either one or two doses of the vaccine are recommended. In the United States two doses are recommended starting at twelve to fifteen months of age. Varicella vaccine Two doses of vaccine are more effective than one. It is given by injection just under the skin. Another vaccine, known as zoster vaccine, is used to prevent diseases caused by the same virus – the varicella zoster virus. One dose of vaccine prevents 95% of moderate disease and 100% of severe disease. If given to those who are not immune within five days of exposure to chickenpox it prevents most cases of the disease. Severe side effects are rare and occur mostly in Varicella vaccine, also known as chickenpox vaccine, is a vaccine that protects against chickenpox. Minor side effects may include pain at the site of injection, fever, and rash. ages 12 and 18 months.
