Christian Berg emphasizes that companies must also change, driven by the necessity to attract talent in a tight labor market. He shares examples of companies that offer full parental leave to both parents to encourage equal participation. 9a50ceeb98 Energy Prices and Policy Design: The discussion turns to energy price volatility. Professor Neuhoﬀ highlights the failures of past energy policies, which allowed producers to profit from price spikes during crises, undermining public trust. He advocates for a redesign of the energy market with

instruments like "contracts for difference," which would secure long-term stable prices for both consumers and businesses, protecting the economy from future shocks.

Professor Neuhoff argues that in order to tackle these crises we have to stay on track or even accelerate the climate transition.
