While 'post-laminectomy syndrome' is still used by some clinicians, PSPS is the preferred label under ICD-11. Many factors can contribute to the onset or development of FBSS, including residual or recurrent spinal disc herniation, persistent post-operative pressure on a spinal nerve, altered joint mobility, joint hypermobility with instability, scar tissue (fibrosis), depression, anxiety, sleeplessness, spinal muscular deconditioning, and Cutibacterium acnes infection. An individual may be predisposed to the development of FBSS by comorbid systemic diseases, including diabetes, autoimmune diseases, and peripheral vascular disease. bb573867b7

About 90% of sciatica is due to a spinal disc herniation pressing on one of the lumbar or sacral nerve roots. Spondylolisthesis, spinal stenosis, piriformis syndrome, pelvic tumors, and pregnancy are other possible causes of sciatica. The straight-leg-raising test is often helpful in diagnosis. The test is positive if, when the leg is raised while a person is lying on their back, pain shoots below the knee. In most cases medical imaging is not needed. However, imaging may be obtained if bowel or bladder function is affected, there is significant loss of feeling or weakness, symptoms are long standing, or there is a concern for tumor or infection. Claudication The word claudication comes from Latin claudicare 'to limp'. This may result from many factors, including bulging disc, herniated disc or fragments from previously herniated discs (post-operative) Claudication is a medical term usually referring to impairment in walking, or pain, discomfort, numbness, or tiredness in the legs that occurs during walking or standing and is relieved by rest. The perceived level of pain from claudication can be mild to extremely severe. Coriolis force Deflection of an object due to the Coriolis force is called the Coriolis effect. On Earth, the Coriolis force will affect the movement of air and water over long distance. In a reference frame with clockwise rotation, the force acts to the left of the motion of the object. Early in the 20th century, the term Coriolis force began to be used in connection with meteorology. bodies, while the last two points (L4 and L5) each form an equilateral triangle with the two large bodies. Though recognized previously by others, the mathematical expression for the Coriolis force appeared in an 1835 paper by French scientist Gaspard-Gustave de Coriolis, in connection with the theory of water wheels. In one with anticlockwise (or counterclockwise) rotation, the force acts to the right. Because of Earth's rotation, the moving object does not travel in a straight line relative to the Earth's surface but follows a curved path bb573867b7

Sciatica is generally caused by the compression of lumbar nerves L4 or L5 or sacral nerve S1. This pain may extend down the back, outside, or front of the leg.
