The oral cavity still acts as a resonance chamber for the sound. Qualitative alterations differ from quantitative alterations, which include anosmia and hyposmia. Dysosmia can be classified as either parosmia (also called troposmia) or phantosmia. Sniffing (behavior) Strategies for sniffing behavior vary depending upon the animal, with small animals (rats, mice, hamsters) displaying sniffing frequencies ranging from 4 to 12 Hz but larger animals (humans) sniffing at much lower frequencies, usually less than 2 Hz. Sniffing is quantified by measuring intra-nasal pressure or flow or air or, while less accurate, through a strain gauge on the chest to measure total respiratory volume. Sniffing is a perceptually-relevant behavior, defined as the active sampling of odors through the nasal cavity for the purpose of information acquisition Sniffing is a perceptually-relevant behavior, defined as the active sampling of odors through the nasal cavity for the purpose of information acquisition. Sniffing is analogous to other stimulus sampling behaviors,

including visual saccades, active touch, and whisker. Subservient sniffing behaviors, evidence for an "olfactomotor" circuit in the brain exists, wherein perception or expectation of an odor can trigger brain respiratory center to allow for the modulation of sniffing frequency and amplitude and thus acquisition of odor information. This behavior, displayed by all terrestrial vertebrates, is typically identified based upon changes in respiratory frequency and/or amplitude, and is often studied in the context of odor guided behaviors and olfactory perceptual tasks 78c90533fa

The principal forms of PAP therapy are continuous positive airway pressure (CPAP), which maintains a constant pressure level; bilevel positive airway pressure (BiPAP or BPAP), which provides different pressures during inhalation and exhalation; and automatic positive airway pressure (APAP), which automatically adjusts pressure in response to breathing patterns. These therapies are used in both home and clinical settings. Breathing apparatus may be classified by type in several ways: By breathing gas source: self-contained gas supply, remotely supplied gas, or purified ambient air Nasal occlusives are nearly universal in human languages. There are also other kinds of nasal consonants in some languages. Spectrovenator is known from a single specimen, MZSP-PV 833, recovered from the Quiricó Formation and stored in the Museu de Zoologia da Universidade de São Paulo, and was discovered in the Embira Branca Range, close to the Coração de Jesus Municipality, located in northern Minas Gerais. The specimen consists of a nearly complete skull, partial series of cervicodorsal vertebrae with ribs, a complete sacrum, partial series of caudal vertebrae, and well-preserved hindlimb and hip bones.

Similarly, the nasals do not form posterior *Stolokrosuchus* is an extinct genus of crocodyliforms found in the Lower Cretaceous Elrhaz Formation, Niger. frontal, this is not the case in *Stolokrosuchus*, in which the posterior edge of the nasals is described as straight. *Stolokrosuchus* is thought to have been a semi-aquatic animal like modern crocodiles and may have fed on fish and other agile prey present in the waterways of the Paleo-Tegama River System. While all of these placements would classify *Stolokrosuchus* as a notosuchian, other studies have proposed a closer relationship to Neosuchia, although these results have been considered to be possibly influenced by its elongated snout

Corythosaurus is known from many complete specimens, including the nearly complete holotype found by Brown in 1911. The holotype skeleton is only missing the last section of the tail and part of the front legs, but was preserved with impressions of polygonal scales. *Corythosaurus* is known from many skulls with tall crests that resemble those of the cassowary and a Corinthian helmet. The most likely function of the crest is thought to be vocalization. As in a trombone, sound waves would travel through many chambers in the crest and then get amplified when *Corythosaurus* exhaled.
