PPE suits can be similar in appearance to a cleanroom suit. Protective clothing is applied to traditional categories of clothing, and protective gear applies to items such as pads, guards, shields, or masks, and others. The hazards addressed by protective equipment include physical, electrical, heat, chemical, biohazards, and airborne particulate matter. Protective equipment may be worn for job-related occupational safety and health purposes, as well as for sports and other recreational activities 76c807aab4

Gloves are generally made of leather or Kevlar and some include carbon fiber knuckle protection. Pants are usually leather, cordura, or Kevlar. This was once quite bulky, but modern technology and materials have made it unobtrusive. Jackets meant for motorcyclists are typically made of leather or specialized man-made fabrics like cordura or Kevlar. This means that PPE involves a sizable range of equipment. The following list, however, sorts personal protective equipment according to function and body area. The term is defined by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA), which is responsible for PPE regulation, as the "equipment that protects employees from serious injury or illness resulting from contact with chemical, radiological, physical, electrical, mechanical, or other hazards. " While there are common forms of PPEs such as gloves, eye shields, and respirators, the standard set in the OSHA definition indicates a wide coverage. There are several ways to classify them such as how gears could be physiological or environmental 76c807aab4

The purpose of personal protective equipment is to reduce employee exposure to hazards when engineering controls and administrative controls are not feasible or effective to reduce these risks to acceptable levels. PPE is needed when there are hazards present. PPE has the serious limitation that it does not eliminate the hazard at the source and may result in employees being exposed to the hazard if the equipment fails. 76c807aab4 In several countries, PPE gowns for use in the COVID-19 pandemic became in appearance more like cleanroom suits as knowledge of the best practices filtered up through the national bureaucracies. NBC suit They are generally designed to be worn for extended periods to allow the wearer to fight (or generally function) while under threat of or under actual nuclear, biological, or chemical attack.
