

Will Ovulation Test Positive If Pregnant

== Terminology == Some people choose to track ovulation in order to improve or aid becoming pregnant by timing intercourse with their ovulation. The signs of ovulation may include cervical mucus changes, mild cramping in the abdominal area, and a small rise in basal body temperature. Medication is also sometimes required by those experiencing infertility to induce ovulation. It is heterodimeric, with an α (alpha) subunit identical to that of luteinizing hormone (LH), follicle-stimulating hormone (FSH), thyroid-stimulating hormone (TSH), and a β (beta) subunit that is unique to hCG.

== Women == Human chorionic gonadotropin is a glycoprotein composed of 237 amino acids with a molecular mass of 36.7 kDa, approximately 14.5kDa α hCG and 22.2kDa β hCG.

Secretion of hCG can occur as soon as 6 days following ovulation and on average 8–10 days following ovulation; this is the earliest hCG can be detected in a blood A pregnancy test is used to determine whether a woman is pregnant or not. Almost all pregnant women will have a positive urine pregnancy test one week after the first day of a missed menstrual period. Testing blood for hCG results in the earliest detection of pregnancy

== Definitions == Throughout history, there have been different animal-based tests with the aim of indicating the pregnancy status of women. The most well

known test is the Hogben test, prevalent from the 1940s to the 1960s, by using the underlying principle of hormones and its subsequent biological response in both sexes of certain frog species. The Galli-Mainini test is another frog test developed based on similar principles.

Human chorionic gonadotropin As ovulation will happen between 38 and 40 hours after a Human chorionic gonadotropin (hCG) is a hormone for the maternal recognition of pregnancy produced by trophoblast cells that are surrounding a growing embryo (syncytiotrophoblast initially), which eventually forms the placenta after implantation. Some cancerous tumors produce this hormone; therefore, elevated levels measured when the patient is not pregnant may lead to a diagnosis of cancer and, if high enough, of paraneoplastic syndromes. The presence of hCG is detected in some pregnancy tests (HCG pregnancy strip tests). The pituitary analogue of hCG, luteinizing hormone (LH), is produced in the pituitary gland of males and females of all ages. one or more mature ovarian follicles, ovulation can be triggered by the administration of HCG. It is unknown however whether this production is a contributing cause or an effect of carcinogenesis

HIV and pregnancy occurs at ovulation, via ovulation test kits and consultation with clinical experts can maximize the chance for conception. LFTs operate on the same principles of affinity chromatography as the enzyme-linked immunosorbent assays (ELISA).
